ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

FRANCIS PHALEN, CPA REINSTATED TO PRACTICE AS AN ACCOUNTANT BEFORE THE COMMISSION

Pursuant to Rule 102(e)(5) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, Francis T Phalen, CPA has applied for and been granted reinstatement of his privilege to appear and practice before the Commission as an accountant. Mr. Phalen, who was suspended from Commission practice on October 2, 1996, pursuant to a settled proceeding, has represented that he has complied and will continue to comply with the terms of the order that suspended him from appearing or practicing before the Commission as an accountant. Mr. Phalen's reinstatement is effective immediately. (Rel. 34-42695; AAE Rel. 1249, File No. 3-9138)

SEC GRANTED DEFAULT JUDGMENT AGAINST FORMER GENERAL MANAGER CHARGED WITH FRAUD ARISING FROM THEFT OF OVER \$400,000

The Commission announced that on April 5 the Honorable Ellen S Huvelle, United States District Judge, District of Columbia, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction by Default against defendant Bradley J. Buchanan, of Sarnia, Ontario, Canada. On September 28, 1999, the Commission filed a civil injunctive action alleging that Buchanan, a former employee of a subsidiary of Thor Industries, Inc., stole corporate funds totaling at least \$415,000. According to the Complaint, to conceal his theft, give the appearance that the subsidiary was operating at a profit when it was not, and to earn performance bonuses, Buchanan made false entries to the subsidiary's books and records over a several year period. The default judgment permanently enjoins Buchanan from further violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, and from further violations of Sections 10(b) and 13(b)(5) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rules 10b-5 and 13b2-1 thereunder. In addition, the default judgment permanently enjoins Buchanan from aiding and abetting further violations of Sections 13(a) and 13(b)(2)(A) of the Exchange Act and Rules 12b-20, 13a-1 and 13a-13 thereunder. The default judgment also permanently bars Buchanan from acting as an officer or director of any issuer required to file periodic reports with the Commission pursuant to Sections 12 or 15(d) of the Exchange Act [SEC v Bradley J. Buchanan, Case No. 1:99CV02567, ESH, D.D.C.] (LR-16518; AAE Rel 1250)

INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST OHIO PLANT MANAGER IN FINANCIAL FRAUD SUIT

The Commission announced that an Order of Permanent Injunction and other Equitable Relief (Order) was entered against David R. Bush (Bush) in *SEC v. ABS Industries, Inc., William J. McCarthy, Theodore Ursu III, John M. McHale, and David R. Bush*, Civil Action No. 1:99CV2600, ND Ohio, Eastern Division. Mr. Bush consented to entry of the Order without admitting or denying any of the allegations made against him in the complaint filed by the Commission. That complaint, filed in October, 1999, alleged that Mr. Bush and other employees and officers of ABS Industries, Inc. (ABS), an Ohio company, defrauded investors in the company's stock by intentionally overstating the company's revenues by millions of dollars in 1994 and the first three quarters of the company's 1995 fiscal year. Specifically, the Commission's complaint alleged that ABS and certain ABS officers and employees engaged in a scheme to prematurely recognize revenue by improperly recording purported "bill and hold" sales at ABS. Also named in the suit with Bush were William J. McCarthy of Ashtabula, Ohio, Theodore Ursu III of Highland Heights, Ohio, and John McHale of Massillon, Ohio.

The Honorable John M. Manos of the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Ohio entered the Order enjoining Bush from further violations of Sections 10(b) and 13(b)(5) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and Rules 10b-5 and 13b2-1 thereunder. The Order partially waived payment of disgorgement and did not impose a civil penalty based on Bush's demonstrated inability to pay such relief. [*SEC v. ABS Industries, Inc., William J. McCarthy, Theodore Ursu III, John M. McHale, and David R. Bush*, Civil Action No. 1:99CV2600, ND Ohio, Eastern Division] (LR-16519)

COMMISSION OBTAINS RULING FROM THE SUPREME COURT OF BRITISH COLUMBIA HOLDING THAT DISGORGEMENT ORDER IN U.S. JUDGMENT IS ENFORCEABLE IN BRITISH COLUMBIA AGAINST DEFENDANT ROBERT COSBY

On March 29, 2000, the Supreme Court of British Columbia issued a ground breaking judgment holding that the disgorgement order against defendant Robert H. Cosby issued by the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York (USDC) in *SEC v. Softpoint, Inc., Robert H. Cosby, Ronald G. Stoecklein, Remington Publications, Inc., and John W. Lane*, 95 Civ. 2951 (SS) (Softpoint Action), was enforceable in British Columbia. In the Softpoint Action, the Commission alleged that Cosby, the former president of Softpoint, Inc., defrauded the public investors of that company and absconded with ill-gotten gains of \$636,928. On August 24, 1996, the USDC entered a final judgment by default against Cosby directing him to disgorge \$779,971 (representing the \$636,928 in proceeds from the fraud plus prejudgment interest) (U.S. judgment). Cosby failed to pay those moneys and fled the United States.

On December 12, 1998, the United States Attorney's Office for the District of Nevada obtained a three-count grand jury indictment against Cosby charging him with money laundering for his handling of the ill-gotten gains he had obtained from the Softpoint fraud. On or about January 16, 1999, Cosby was stopped by Canadian authorities at the Vancouver

International Airport in Vancouver, British Columbia, while seeking to enter Canada on a flight from Hong Kong. Cosby was questioned by Canadian immigration officials and the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP), who discovered on Cosby's person approximately \$100,000 in cash. The RCMP seized these funds and refused Cosby entry to Canada.

On April 22, 1999, the Commission filed an action in the Supreme Court of British Columbia seeking enforcement of the U.S. judgment against Cosby and recovery of the funds held by the RCMP. Cosby, through Global Action Investments Limited, a corporation which the Commission alleged was owned or controlled by Cosby, opposed the Commission's application before the Supreme Court of British Columbia, asserting that the Commission's U.S. Judgment was not enforceable in British Columbia because it was allegedly "penal" in nature. In its recent decision, the Supreme Court of British Columbia held that the disgorgement relief in the U.S. Judgment was not a "foreign penal claim" and is enforceable in British Columbia. This ruling should enhance the Commission's efforts to return funds fraudulently obtained from investors that may have been transferred to Canada.

On July 16, 1999, Hong Kong authorities arrested Cosby and commenced extradition proceedings for Cosby's return to the United States pursuant to an official request by the United Department of Justice. [SEC v. Robert H. Cosby and Global Action Investments Limited, The Supreme Court of British Columbia, No. C992041, Vancouver Register] (LR-16520)

FINAL JUDGMENTS ENTERED IN "PONZI" SCHEME

On April 14, Judge Terry R. Means, United States District Judge for the Northern District of Texas, entered Permanent Injunctions against Cornerstone Prodigy Group, Inc. and its principals Gary D. Reeder, a convicted felon, and Sandra Reeder, a licensed securities professional.

The Court's order enjoins Cornerstone and the Reeders, which they consented to, from future violations of the anti-fraud and securities registration provisions of the federal securities laws. The Court also ordered the Reeders to disgorge \$16.5 million, less the approximately \$6 million of investor funds recovered to date, but waived the balance based upon the Reeders' demonstrated financial inability to pay. The court-appointed receiver will distribute the recovered funds to the victims of the Reeders' fraud.

The Commission's Complaint alleged that since 1999, the Reeders raised over \$16.5 million from over 600 investors. The Commission alleged that the defendants promised investors a 120% annual returns when, in reality, they had no significant business activity. According to the Complaint, the Reeders were operating a *Ponzi* scheme. [SEC v. Cornerstone Prodigy Group, Inc., Gary D. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change (SR-Amex-00-15) filed by the American Stock Exchange relating to transaction, clearance and floor brokerage fees has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of April 17 (Rel. 34-42675)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-99-25) eliminating the requirement that the Chairman also be the CEO. (Rel. 34-42687)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed change (SR-NYSE-99-30) that would amend its Listed Company Manual and Exchange Rule 499 with respect to its delisting procedures and issuer appeals. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of April 17. (Rel. 34-42689)
