### ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

# SUMMARY JUDGMENT GRANTED IN FAVOR OF COMMISSION AGAINST DEFENDANT LLOYD WILLIAM SAHLEY

The Commission announced that on January 7 Judge John S. Martin of the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York granted summary judgment in favor of the Commission against defendant Lloyd William Sahley. The Court granted all relief requested in the Commission's complaint, including: a permanent injunction restraining Sahley from further violations of the antifraud provisions of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and Rule 10b-5 thereunder; an order requiring Sahley to disgorge \$950,000, plus prejudgment interest of \$152,197.31 for a total amount of \$1,102,197.31; the assessment of a civil penalty of \$100,000 against Sahley pursuant to the Securities Enforcement Remedies and Penny Stock Reform Act of 1990 (Remedies Act); and an Order barring Sahley from serving as an officer or director of a public company under the Remedies Act. # INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

# NWNL NORTHSTAR SERIES TRUST, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 8, 1994 to request a hearing on an application filed by NWNL Northstar Series Trust, et al. for a conditional order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 18(f), 18(g), 18(i), 22(c), and 22(d) and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The order would permit certain investment companies to issue multiple classes of shares representing interests in the same portfolio, and to impose a contingent deferred sales charge (CDSC) on certain redemptions of shares, and to waive the CDSC under certain circumstances. ### STANDARD CHARTERED BANK

An conditional order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Standard Chartered Bank (SCB) from Section 17(f) of the Act to permit the maintenance of foreign securities and other assets of registered investment companies with Standard Chartered Bank Malaysia Berhad, a wholly-owned subsidiary of SCB. # PROTECTIVE LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Protective Life Insurance Company, Protective Variable Annuity Separate Account (Variable Account) and Investment Distributors, Inc. from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. The exemptions apply to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risks charges from the assets of the Variable Account in connection with the issuance and sale of certain flexible premium deferred variable and fixed annuity contracts. ### SECURITY LIFE OF DENVER INSURANCE COMPANY ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 14, 1994 to request a hearing on an application filed by Security Life of Denver Insurance Company, Security Life Separate Account Al (Separate Account), certain separate accounts that may be created in the future, and SLD Equities, Inc. for an order that would permit the Applicants to deduct a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of the Separate Account. # HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

## SYSTEM ENERGY RESOURCES, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by System Energy Resources, Inc., an electric public-utility subsidiary company of Entergy Corporation, a registered holding company, to cause the sale of up to \$435.102 million of secured lease obligation bonds, interim long-term notes or trust certificates through December 31, 1995 to be used to refund an aggregate principal amount \$435.102 of outstanding secured lease obligation bonds. # SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

### UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 3, 1994 to comment on the application of the <u>Chicago Stock Exchange</u> for unlisted trading privileges in 17 issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. (Rel. 34-33481)

### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR NASD-94-3) that became effective upon filing with the Commission to provide notice of the adjustment of the credit against gross income assessments of NASD member firms from 67% to 59% and to amend the calendar year dates from 1993 to 1994. Publication of the order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of January 24. (Rel. 34-33488)
