#### COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

DIVISION OF CORPORATION FINANCE ANNOUNCES TERMINATION DATE FOR EARLY REVIEW PROXY PROGRAM

With the conclusion of the 1994 proxy season, the Division of Corporation Finance has established September 2, 1994 as the last day for submitting draft executive compensation disclosure for review prior to filing with the Commission. Until that date, drafts may continue to be submitted to the attention of John Bernas of the Division of Corporation Finance by facsimile to (202) 272-7546 or by mail to the Securities & Exchange Commission, 450 Fifth Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20549, mail stop 3-4. Issuers submitting the information on EDGAR should use the document tag <CORRESP> to ensure that the information remains non-public. #### ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

#### MERRITT BRADT SANCTIONED

The Commission issued an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions by Default (Order) against Merritt L. Bradt (Bradt) of Port St. Lucie, Florida. Bradt was formerly associated with Prudential Securities Incorporated (Prudential) as a registered representative. The Order bars Bradt from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company.

The Commission's Order found that on October 13, 1993, Bradt was permanently enjoined from violating, among other things, the registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The Order found that the complaint in the injunctive action alleged that between October 1990 and March 1992, Bradt sold interests in limited partnerships formed and managed by Omni Capital Group, Ltd. "Omni), a

closely-held Delaware corporation, in unregistered, non-exempt transactions to over 80 investors. The Order further found that the complaint alleged that to induce offerees to invest, Bradt made material misrepresentations and omissions of material facts concerning, among other things, the return on investment, the risk factors associated with an investment and Omni's business operations. The Order found that the complaint alleged that Bradt raised \$9 million for Omni and received over \$500,000 in undisclosed commissions. (Rel. 34-34437)

# PEARCE SYSTEMS INTERNATIONAL, INC. ORDERED TO CEASE AND DESIST

On July 25, the Commission instituted a public administrative proceeding pursuant to Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act) against Pearce Systems International, Inc. (Pearce) in connection with its unregistered offers and sales of Pearce securities in violation of the registration provisions of the federal securities laws.

Pearce, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, consented to the issuance of an Order by the Commission which finds that it violated the securities registration provisions. The Commission's Order alleges, among other things, that Pearce's underwriter formed a limited partnership for the sole purpose of purchasing Pearce securities from Pearce; the partnership was created to evade the registration requirements of the federal securities laws; the underwriter sold units in the partnership nationwide through cold calls; the partnership then purchased securities from Pearce; and that the offers and sales of securities were required to be registered under Section 5 of the Securities Act. #### JAMES GILMORE HELD IN CIVIL CONTEMPT

On July 26, the Honorable Orinda D. Evans issued an order holding defendant James B. Gilmore (Gilmore) in civil contempt of the Court's October 8 and 15, 1992 orders freezing the assets of the defendant International Trading, Inc. (ITI). To purge himself of this contempt, Gilmore was ordered to repay ITI funds totalling \$81,400 that he had obtained in violation of the Court's orders. The failure to pay this sum by August 19, 1994 will result in Gilmore's arrest and incarceration until such time as the payment is made or as required by law.

The Commission filed its complaint and obtained a temporary restraining order against Gilmore and other defendants on October 8, 1992 which, among other things, froze the assets of Gilmore and ITI. The complaint alleged that Gilmore and others engaged in the fraudulent sale of more than \$4.5 million of securities to more than 1,000 investors, promising returns of up to \$13 million for each \$1,000 invested. These exorbitant returns were purported to be paid from a fortune accumulated by a deceased European "financier" and claimed to be in excess of \$1 trillion. The complaint alleges that the purported fortune does not exist.

Shortly after consenting to a preliminary injunction on October 15, 1992, which continued the freeze on his own and ITI's assets, Gilmore travelled to England and directed his attorney there to pay Gilmore certain ITI funds. The Court's order directs Gilmore to repay these sums. [SEC v. Sam S. Brown Jr., et al., USDC, ND Ga., Civil Action File No. 1:92-CV-2396-ODE] (LR-14177)

# FORMER FIRST ALLIANCE TRADING LIAISON SENTENCED

The United States Attorney for the Northern District of Georgia, the Commission, and the Office of the Georgia Secretary of State announced that on July 27 the Honorable G. Ernest Tidwell, United States District Judge for the Northern District of Georgia, sentenced Victor H. Strevel (Strevel) to fifty-seven months imprisonment, three years supervised release and joint and severable liability for trading losses of \$3,339,000.

Strevel had pled guilty in the same court on November 18, 1993, to an existing one-count indictment charging him with structuring to avoid the filing of a currency transaction report by a domestic financial institution and to a fourteen-count criminal information charging him with one count of conspiracy to commit securities fraud, twelve counts of securities fraud, and one count of financial structuring. At the time of the crimes for which Strevel was sentenced, he was associated with First Alliance Securities, Inc. (First Alliance), formerly a registered broker-dealer headquartered in Atlanta, Georgia.

The information charged, among other things, that from in or about March 1989 until in or about September 1989, while serving as an unregistered principal and trading department liaison of First Alliance, Strevel conspired with others to defraud investors by the use of high-pressure, badgering telephone sales techniques, unauthorized trading in customer accounts, the promotion of certain First Alliance stocks on certain days to create the appearance of demand, and the promotion of stocks at prices which included undisclosed excessive markups. Such markups generated approximately \$1.4 million from First Alliance investors.

The twelve counts of securities fraud involved separate transactions in which Strevel either obtained undisclosed profits by structuring transactions in nominee accounts or purchased and sold securities in his own account in a manner which disadvantaged other First Alliance investors. [U.S. v. Victor H. Strevel, Criminal Information 1:93-CR-500, N.D. Ga.] (LR-14176)

ORDER OF SUSPENSION OF TRADING ENTERED AGAINST LATIN AMERICAN RESOURCES, INC.

On August 1, the Commission announced the temporary suspension, pursuant to Section 12(k) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act),

of over-the-counter trading of the securities of Latin American Resources, Inc. (LARI) of Huntington Station, New York for a ten-day period commencing at 9:15 a.m. (EDT) on August 1, 1994 and terminating at 11:59 p.m. (EDT) on August 10, 1994. The Commission temporarily suspended trading in the securities of LARI in view of questions that have been raised about the accuracy and adequacy of LARI's financial statements and other disclosures. # TCW INVESTMENT FUNDS, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 22 to request a hearing on an application filed by TCW Investment Funds, Inc. for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-20432 - July 28)

#### ONTARIO FINANCING AUTHORITY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 22 to request a hearing on an application filed by Ontario Financing Authority for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from all provisions of the Act. Applicant seeks an order to permit it to offer and sell debt securities in the United States that will be unconditionally guaranteed by the Province of Ontario, Canada. (Rel. # MFS VARIABLE INSURANCE TRUST, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 22 to request a hearing on an application filed by MFS Variable Insurance Trust (Trust) and Massachusetts Financial Services Company (together with the Trust, the Applicants). Applicants seek an order pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 9(a), 13(a), 15(a) and 15(b) of the Act and Rules 6e-2(b)(15) and 6e-3(T)(b)(15) thereunder to the extent necessary to permit shares of the Trust to be sold to and held by separate accounts funding variable annuity and variable life insurance contracts issued by both affiliated and unaffiliated life insurance companies; and qualified pension and retirement plans outside of the separate account context. # FGIC CAPITAL MARKET SERVICES, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 23 to request a hearing on an application filed by FGIC Capital Market Services, Inc. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act that would exempt applicant from paragraphs (a)(5), (a)(6), and (b) of Rule 3a-5. ### PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>Philadelphia Depository Trust Company</u> and <u>Stock Clearing Corporation of Philadelphia</u> filed proposed rule changes (SR-Philadep-94-01 and SR-SCCP-94-03) to amend Philadep's and SCCP's By-Laws dealing with the composition of the respective Boards of Directors and Nominating Committees. Publication of the proposals is expected in the Federal Register during the week of August 1. (Rel. 34-34446)

The <u>Boston Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-BSE-94-01) to establish a northbound trading linkage with the Montreal Stock Exchange (ME) that would permit the routing of orders for ME listed stocks through the BSE's BEACON system for execution on the ME. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 1. (Rel. 34-34456; International Series Rel. 693)

The <u>Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-MSRB-94-9) to initiate a pilot program to require reports of sales or purchases, and to initiate procedures for reporting inter-dealer transactions pursuant to MSRB Rule G-14. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 1. (Rel. 34-34458)

# AMENDMENT OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed Amendment No. 2 to its proposed rule change (SR-NASD-94-13) to implement a new system, referred to as the Nasdaq Primary Retail Order View and Execution System (N.PROVE), for execution and price improvement of small-sized customer orders. If approved, N.PROVE will replace in its entirety the NASD's Small Order Execution System (SOES), which the NASD proposes to terminate simultaneous with N.PROVE becoming operational. The Amendment concerns the handling of limit orders in N.PROVE. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of August 1. (Rel. 34-34453)

#### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> (SR-Phlx-94-14) to amend the Exchange's order and decorum regulations to, among other things, prohibit indecorous behavior which is disruptive to business on the Exchange floor, and adopt a range of fines for abusive, derisive or harassing conduct on the floor, which, in the view of two floor officials could constitute a public embarrassment to the Exchange.
