## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

CHAIRMAN LEVITT ANNOUNCES SEARCH FOR NEW EEO DIRECTOR

Chairman Arthur Levitt has commissioned a special executive committee to undertake a nationwide search for a new Director of the Commission's Office of Equal Employment Opportunity. The EEO Director reports directly to the Office of the Chairman and, working with the Agency's senior staff, is responsible for implementing the full range of equal opportunity laws, regulations, and policies. The Committee will be led by Commissioner Richard Y. Roberts and include the following senior staff of the agency:

Juan Marcelino, District Administrator -- Boston James McConnell, Executive Director Julio Mojica, Assistant Director -- Market Regulation Lori Richards, Executive Assistant and Senior Advisor to the Chairman

Since his appointment, Chairman Levitt has identified equal opportunity and increased diversity as a priority for the SEC. He has charged this Committee with the mission of identifying a talented and dedicated individual for this important position. The search will begin immediately and include both the traditional federal competitive recruitment process as well as private sector channels.

DIVISION OF CORPORATION FINANCE ANNOUNCES TERMINATION DATE FOR EARLY REVIEW PROXY PROGRAM

# RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

CONCEPT RELEASE REGARDING NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED STATISTICAL RATING ORGANIZATIONS

The Commission issued a concept release soliciting comment on a number of questions concerning the use of the term "nationally recognized statistical rating organization" (NRSRO) in the Commission's rules. This concept release examines the process employed by the Commission to designate rating agencies as NRSROs and the nature of the Commission's oversight role with respect to NRSROS. PROPOSED RULES REGARDING DISCLOSURE OF SECURITIES RATINGS

On August 31, the Commission issued a release proposing new rules regarding disclosure with respect to security ratings in prospectuses under the Securities Act of 1933 and material changes in security ratings on Form 8-K under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposals would require disclosure of ratings obtained by or on behalf of an issuer from a nationally recognized statistical rating organization (NRSRO) for registered securities or any rating, whether or not assigned by an NRSRO, that is used by a participant in the offering. ### ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST TIMOTHY MOBLEY

The Commission announced that public administrative proceedings were instituted against Timothy Mobley (Mobley). The Order Instituting Proceedings (Order) alleges that, between October 1986 and June 1988,

Mobley violated and aided and abetted violations of the antifraud and books and records provisions of the federal securities laws. Specifically, the Order alleges that Mobley made misrepresentations of material facts and omitted to state material facts to investors concerning the fact that securities he sold to investors were being manipulated, that Mobley was receiving excessive commissions for selling these securities, and that investors could experience difficulty in selling the securities unless Mobley found a buyer for an equal or greater number of shares. In addition, the Order alleges that Mobley established and executed personal securities transactions in an account which was in the name of another individual. Furthermore, the Order alleges that on March 17, 1994, after a trial was held in the matter on March 2, 1994, the United States District Court for the District of Nevada entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction (Final Judgment) The Final Judgment made findings regarding Mobley's against Mobley. violations and aiding and abetting violations of the antifraud and books and records provisions of the federal securities laws. The Final Judgment also found that Mobley had given false answers in sworn testimony before Commission staff members and enjoined Mobley from further violations of the above-noted provisions of the federal securities laws.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine what, if any, remedial action would be appropriate against Mobley. (Rel. 34-34593)

PENNY STOCK PROMOTERS AND BROKERS NAMED IN FRAUDULENT KICKBACK SCHEME

The Commission announced the filing of a complaint in the U.S. District Court for the District of Massachusetts naming Robert L. Shull, Leonard E. Fiessel, Colleen A. Fiessel, Patrick A. Collins, Mark J. Hamel, Robert J. Raffa, Jeffrey J. Fernandez, Michael J. Murphy and William Cho as Defendants. The complaint seeks the entry of a permanent injunction and an order for disgorgement and civil monetary penalties for violations of Sections 5 and 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 promulgated thereunder. The Commission and the U.S. Attorney for the District of Massachusetts also announced that in a related criminal action Raffa was charged with securities fraud and conspiracy in an eleven-count information.

The complaint alleges that, from January 1993 through September 1993, Shull, L. Fiessel and Collins paid kickbacks worth more than \$400,000 to Hamel, Raffa, Fernandez, Murphy and Cho, each of whom was a registered representative of a U.S. broker-dealer. The kickbacks were paid to induce those registered representatives to recommend and solicit purchases of the common stock of Fairmont Resources Inc. (Fairmont), a start-up Canadian oil and gas company. The complaint further alleges that more than 150 customers of those registered representatives in seventeen states purchased over 1,000,000 shares of Fairmont stock at prices artificially enhanced by the kickbacks.
