# RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO LEGAL PROCEEDINGS DISCLOSURE

The Commission yesterday issued a release (No. 33-7106) proposing amendments to Regulation S-K Item 401(f) and other provisions requiring disclosure of legal proceedings involving directors, executive officers and others who direct the affairs of public companies that would: (1) expand the categories of legal proceedings required to be discussed in various filed documents; (2) extend the reporting period for such disclosure from the current five years to 10 years; (3) conform provisions of forms and schedules that currently require disclosure of legal proceedings; and (4) add legal proceedings disclosure provisions to registration statement forms used by registered investment companies.

CONCEPT RELEASE ON MODERNIZATION OF REGULATION OF PUBLIC-UTILITY HOLDING COMPANIES

The Securities and Exchange Commission has issued a concept release and request for comments on modernization of the regulation of publicutility holding companies. The concept release relates to the Commission's thorough reevaluation of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935 as a result of developments in recent years. The result of the one-year review will be a study of the Commission's regulation of utility holding companies under the Act. The study is expected to be published in the summer of 1995.

#### ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

BROKER-DEALER REGISTRATION OF SAN MARINO SECURITIES IS REVOKED

The Commission has issued an Order Making Findings and Revoking Registration with respect to San Marino Securities, Inc., a Salt Lake City broker-dealer (San Marino). The findings and sanction are in accordance with an Offer of Settlement submitted by San Marino whereby it consented to entry of the Order.

Pursuant to the Order and Offer, the Commission found that San Marino failed to fully comply with an October 3, 1990 order of the United States District Court for the District of Utah which ordered San Marino to make an offer of rescission to any of its customers to whom it sold securities in violation of Section 15(c) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 15c2-6 thereunder. This failure resulted in violations of the broker-dealer net capital and books and records provisions of the Exchange Act. The Commission found that San Marino had significant net capital deficiencies as of May 31, 1991 and June 28, 1991. Finally, the Commission found that San Marino failed to disclose in its application for registration as a broker-dealer that it self-cleared transactions. Based upon these findings, the Commission revoked San Marino's registrations as a broker-dealer. (Rel. 34-34901)

CEASE AND DESIST ORDER ENTERED AGAINST DAVID CHANDLER

The Commission announced the issuance of an Order pursuant to Section 12C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against David L. Chandler (Chandler), requiring Chandler to permanently cease and desist from committing or causing any violation of, or any future violation of, Sections 13(d) and 16(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 13d-2, 16a-3 promulgated thereunder. Chandler, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's Order, consented to its entry. Chandler is the Chairman of the Board of Directors and Chief Executive Officer of Redlaw Industries, Inc. (Redlaw) and Johnston Industries, Inc. (Johnston). The Order finds that for periods up to approximately three years and three months Chandler failed to file a Schedule 13D and five amendments for his ownership of Redlaw stock, and that for periods up to fifteen years Chandler failed to file a Form 3 and twelve Forms 4 and 5 for transactions in Redlaw involving a combined value of \$2,298,448. Chandler also failed for periods up to approximately thirteen years to file a Form 3 and four Forms 4 for transactions in Johnston involving a combined value of \$671,330. Redlaw's shares are traded on the American Stock Exchange and Johnston's shares are traded on the New York Stock Exchange. (Rel. 34-34904)

# LAURENCE BROWN BARRED

The Securities and Exchange Commission announced that Laurence M. Brown consented to the issuance of an Order Instituting Public Administrative Proceedings, Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions that bars him from association with any broker, dealer, government securities broker, government securities dealer, investment company, investment adviser or municipal securities dealer.

The Order was based on a final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief entered in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York against Brown. Brown consented, without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint, to the entry of the Final Judgment. The complaint alleges that, from in or about January 1986 to in or about December 1989, Brown violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws by soliciting investors to deposit money for the purchase of government securities. No securities were purchased with the investors' monies and Brown misappropriated approximately 1,704,331 of the 2,694,681 raised. In addition, Brown operated his firm, Phoenix Capital Group, Inc., as an unregistered government securities broker-dealer and as an unregistered brokerdealer. (Rel. 34-34905)

# COMMISSION ISSUES CEASE AND DESIST ORDER AGAINST PANTHEON INDUSTRIES, INC., LANNY LANG AND RONALD MARSH

The Commission entered an Order pursuant to Section 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, ordering Pantheon Industries, Inc. (Pantheon), Lanny Lang (Lang), and Ronald Marsh (Marsh) to cease and desist from violating certain provisions of the Exchange Act. Pantheon was ordered to cease and desist from violating the antifraud, reporting, books and records, and internal control provisions of the Exchange Act; Lang was ordered to cease and desist from violating the reporting, books and records, falsification of books and records and internal control provisions of the Exchange Act; and Marsh was order to cease and desist from violating the antifraud, report, and books and records provisions of the Exchange Act. The respondents consented to the Order without admitting or denying the Commission's findings.

The Order finds that Marsh sold to Pantheon \$40 million in forged bearer notes purportedly issued by the Krung Thia Bank. Pantheon reported the notes as assets in its fiscal year 1991 Form 10-K and first quarter 1992 Form 10-Q, causing Pantheon to materially overstate its assets. The Order also finds that Lang, Pantheon's then Chief Financial Officer, was concerned about the notes' authenticity but recorded the notes as assets without verifying their authenticity. (Rel. 34-34907) STEVEN HOFFENBERG IS PERMANENTLY ENJOINED AND ORDERED TO PAY DISGORGEMENT, PRE-JUDGMENT INTEREST AND PENALTIES

United States District Judge Whitman Knapp has entered a final judgment of permanent injunction and other relief against Steven Hoffenberg (Hoffenberg) by consent. Without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint, Hoffenberg consented to the entry of a final judgment of permanent injunction, which permanently enjoins him from violating Sections 5 and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. Hoffenberg is ordered to disgorge \$29,196,797 in unlawful profits, \$7,941,560 in prejudgment interest thereon, and a penalty of \$22,832,257. Hoffenberg is also barred from becoming an officer or director of any public company, pursuant to the consent judgment. [SEC v. Towers Financial Corp, et al., 93 Civ.0744, WK, S.D.N.Y] (LR-14317)

#### INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

# THE STANDARD BANK OF SOUTH AFRICA

Two orders have been issued under Section 6(c) of teh Investment Company Act that granted an exemption from Section 17(f) of the Act. The orders permit registered investment companies to maintain custody of foreign securities and other assets in certain African countries with certain affiliates of The Standard Bank of South Africa, Ltd. (Rel. IC-20676 -November 1)

## LEXINGTON EMERGING MARKETS FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 28 to request a hearing on an application filed by Lexington Emerging Markets Fund, Inc. (Fund), Lexington Natural Resources Trust (Trust), and Lexington Management Corporation (collectively Applicants). Applicants request that the Commission issued an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act for exemptive relief from Section 9(a), 13(a), 15(a) and 15(b) and Rules 63-2(b)(15) and 6e-3(T)(b)(15) thereunder. Applicants seek exemptive relief to the extent necessary to permit shares of any current or future investment series of the Trust and the Fund to be sold to and held by the separate accounts funding variable annuity and variable life insurance companies. ## CHUNG KHIAW BANK

A conditional order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Chung Khiaw Bank, Ltd. (CKB) from Section 17(f) of the Act to permit the maintenance of foreign securities and other assets of registered investment companies, other than investment companies registered under Section 7(d), with Chung Khiaw Bank (Malaysia) Bhd., a subsidiary of CKB. #### SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

#### PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>New York Stock Exchange</u> has filed a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-94-31) under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 to require written notification to the NYSE within forty-eight hours of significant decreases in tentative net capital of members and member organizations. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal</u> <u>Register</u> during the week of November 7. (Rel. 34-34924)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved proposed rule changes (SR-OCC-94-04, SR-OCC-94-05, SR-OCC-94-07) filed by the <u>Option Clearing Corporation</u> under Section 19(b) of the Exchange Act. The rule changes provide for the acceptance of flexibly structured options, inverse foreign currency options, cross-rate foreign currency options, and flexibly structured cross-rate foreign currency options. ORDER APPROVING PROPOSED RULE CHANGE AND NOTICE OF FILING AND ORDER GRANTING ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT

The Commission has granted approval of a proposed rule change (SR-PHLX-94-18) and has granted accelerated approval of Amendment No. 3 to the proposed rule change filed by the <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> relating to customized foreign currency options. Publication of the notice and order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of November 7. (Rel. 34-34925)
