ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

GABELLI & COMPANY, INC. AND GAMCO INVESTORS, INC. CONSENT TO THE ENTRY OF CEASE-AND-DESIST ORDERS, CIVIL PENALTIES, AND REMEDIAL SANCTIONS FOR FAILURE TO HAVE ADEQUATE COMPLIANCE PROCEDURES

The Commission today announced that administrative proceedings were instituted pursuant to Sections 15(b)(4) and 21C of the Exchange Act and Sections 203(e)(4) and 203(k) of the Advisers Act against Gabelli & Company, Inc., a registered broker-dealer, and GAMCO Investors, Inc., a registered investment adviser affiliated with Gabelli & Company (Gabelli entities), to determine whether the Gabelli entities failed to establish, maintain, and enforce written procedures reasonably designed to prevent the misuse of material, nonpublic information as required by the Insider Trading and Securities Fraud Enforcement Act of 1988 (ITSFEA).

Simultaneously, without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations, the Respondents entered into a settlement agreement with the Commission. In the settlement agreement, the Gabelli entities consented to the entry of a cease-and-desist order, to pay \$100,000 in civil penalties, and to appoint an Independent Consultant to evaluate their current procedures. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS AGAINST JOSEPH KEMPROWSKI AND THE CAMBRIDGE CONSULTING CO.

The Commission today announced the entry of an Order Instituting Proceedings Pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 21C of the Exchange Act and Findings, Cease and Desist Order and Order Imposing Sanctions (Order) against Joseph Kemprowski (Kemprowski) and The Cambridge Consulting Co. (Cambridge). The Commission accepted Kemprowski's and Cambridge's Offers of Settlement.

The Order finds that during the period from approximately November 1988 through May 1990, Kemprowski and Cambridge, without registering wit the Commission, acted as brokers by, directly and indirectly, inducing and attempting to induce the purchase of Astro Enterprises, Inc. (Astro) stock; and, while acting as brokers, disseminated false and misleading information issued by Astro and recommended the purchase of Astro stock, directly and indirectly, to potential investors without having any reasonable basis for the recommendation.

Under the terms of the Offers of Settlement, Kemprowski and Cambridge, without admitting or denying the findings contained in the Order, consented to the entry of the Order that ordered each to cease and desist from committing or causing any violation, and from committing or causing any future violation, of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Sections 10(b), 15(a) and 15(c)(1) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and Rules 10b-5, 15b1-1 and 15c1-2 thereunder; barred each from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser, or investment company with the provision that after five years from the date of the entry of the order, Kemprowski and Cambridge may apply to become so associated; and ordered them to disgorge an amount of \$135,000, representing the amount received from their illegal activities. Payment of disgorgement was waived based upon the inability of Kemprowski and Cambridge to pay. (Rel. 34-35058)

CIVIL ACTION AGAINST ERNST HIESTAND, ET AL.

The Commission today announced the filing of a complaint in the Unite's States District Court for the District of Columbia seeking permaner injunctions and other equitable relief against certain Canadian, Swiss and U.S. residents -- Ernst Hiestand (E. Hiestand), Thomas Hiestand (T. Hiestand), Elizabeth Kuriger (Kuriger), Henry Strubin (Strubin), Peter Thaler (Thaler), Leonard Gotshalk (Gotshalk), and Astro Enterprises, Inc. (Astro).

The complaint alleges that E. Hiestand and his brother T. Hiestand, and a group of investors they formed, acquired 80% of the stock of a shell corporation which became Astro. The complaint also alleges that Astro, directly and indirectly, disseminated to the public materially false and misleading information concerning its business and business prospects through press releases, a registration statement and other means. According to the complaint, E. Hiestand, who directed the management and policies of Astro, and Astro's officers, Strubin, Thaler and Gotshalk, participated in drafting and disseminating to the public some or all of the materially false and misleading information.

In addition, the complaint alleges that, at or around times when the materially false and misleading information was disseminated, E. Hiestand and T. Hiestand caused the group of investors they formed to sell Astro securities in the U.S.; and that Kuriger, E. Hiestand's and T. Hiestand's sister and a member of the group of investors, also sold Astro stock in the U.S. According to the complaint, no registration statement for Astro stock was in effect at the time of the sales. In addition, the complaint alleges that at least part of the proceeds from these stock sales were used to fund Astro's business operations. Further, the complaint alleges that E. Hiestand, T. Hiestand and Kuriger failed to file a Schedule 13G, and that Astro failed to file periodic reports.

The complaint seeks to enjoin E. Hiestand, T. Hiestand, Kuriger, Strubin, Thaler, Gotshalk and Astro variously from violating the registration, antifraud and reporting provisions of the federal securities laws. The complaint also seeks an accounting and disgorgement from E. Hiestand, T. Hiestand and Kuriger of all profits and monies received and losses avoided as a result of the illegal activities set forth in the complaint.

Simultaneously with the filing of the complaint, and without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint, Thaler consented to the entry of a Final Judgment, permanently enjoining him from future violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5.
