COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

CHAIRMAN BREEDEN ANNOUNCES HIS RESIGNATION

Chairman Breeden announced today that he intends to submit his resignation to President Clinton and return to the private sector not later than April 15, 1993, unless a successor is in place sooner.

In making his announcement the Chairman said, "Since October 11, 1989, I have had the extraordinary privilege of leading the men and women of the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission. It has been a time of great change in securities markets in the United States and around the world. The SEC Chairman's job is a tough one, filled with highly complex issues and some of the toughest decisions anyone has to make. Though my period of service under President Clinton will have been brief, I appreciate his expression of confidence in allowing me to continue as Chairman under his Presidency." (Press Rel. 93-2)

AMENDMENTS TO THE DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY TO THE GENERAL COUNSEL

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS AGAINST MICHAEL TRIKILIS, THOMAS LACHAPELLE AND BARBARA ALDRIGE

On February 10, the Commission announced that Michael Trikilis (Trikilis) and Thomas LaChapelle (LaChapelle) have consented to entry of judgments against them pursuant to a complaint filed in the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California

on March 2, 1993. The complaint alleged that each defendant violated Sections 10(b) and 14(e) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rules 10b-5 and 14e-3 thereunder by trading in the common stock and options of Marion Laboratories, Inc. (Marion) while in possession of material, nonpublic information.

Without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations Trikilis consented to the a permanent injunction against future violations, disgorgement of \$400,969.95 in profits, \$156,716.88 in prejudgment interest and a civil penalty of \$100,000.

Without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations LaChapelle consented to a permanent injunction against future violations, disgorgement of \$15,799.25 in profits, \$6,179.31 in prejudgment interest and civil penalty of \$7,899.63.

The judgments were entered on January 20, 1993. On January 22, 1993, the Court also vacated its Order of July 28, 1992, which had held, among other things, that Rule 14e-3 of the Exchange Act is violated only when a trader in possession of material nonpublic information knows that the information is related to a tender offer. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NEW ENGLAND MUTUAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c), 26(a)(1), 26(a)(2), 27)(a)(1), 27(a)(3), 27(c)(1), 27(c)(2), 27(d) and 27(e) of the and Rules 6e-2(b)(1), (b)(12), (b)(13)(i), (b)(13)(ii), (b)(13)(iii), (b)(13)(iv), (b)(13)(v), (b)(13)(vii),(c)(1) and (c)(4) and 22c-1 and 27e-1 thereunder. The exemptions permit the New England Mutual Life Insurance Company, New England Variable Life Insurance Company, New England Variable Life Separate Account (Variable Account) and New England Securities Corporation to issue certain variable life insurance policies. policies provide for a death benefit that will not always vary based on investment experience, both a contingent deferred sales charge and a sales charge deducted from premiums, and a contingent deferred administrative charge. The policies also provide for deduction from the policy's account value for the cost of insurance charges, charges for substandard mortality risks and incidental insurance benefits, and a minimum death benefit guarantee charge. In addition, the policies provide for values and charges based on the 1980 Commissioners' Standard Ordinary Mortality Tables and the holding of mutual fund shares funding the Variable Account without the use of a trustee, in an open account arrangement and without a trust indenture. Finally, the policies provide for a waiver of notice of refund and withdrawal rights. (Rel. IC-19261 - February 10)
