CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMMISSION FILES SUIT AGAINST COSTA RICAN TEAK PLANTATION AND TWO OF ITS OFFICERS

The Commission filed a civil complaint on April 12 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida against Bosque Puerto Carrillo (Bosque) and two of its officers, Ralf Stefan Jaeckel (Jaeckel) and Terence James Ennis (Ennis). The complaint charged Bosque, Jaeckel and Ennis with violating the registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws.

According to the complaint, the defendants violated Section 5(a) and (c) of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act) by offering and selling securities in the United States without registering them with the Commission. The complaint alleges that the defendants offered to sell a total of more than \$67 million in unregistered securities through various means, including causing advertisements and articles promoting Bosque securities to be placed in the in-flight magazines of American Airlines and Lacsa Airlines, and sold unregistered Bosque securities to at least forty United States investors.

The complaint also charges that to promote the unregistered securities, Jaeckel, Ennis and Bosque disseminated advertisements, articles, and offering circulars containing materially false or misleading statements and omitting various material facts, in violation of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. According to the complaint, the defendants, among other things, materially overstated the return on investments

in Bosque securities and the value of wood that could be grown on the plantation; failed to disclose that Costa Rican law prohibits the export of unprocessed logs, Bosque's sole product; and falsely minimized or omitted to disclose known risks to the cultivation of teak trees.

The complaint seeks a permanent injunction restraining the defendants from violating the registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws, and an order requiring them to make an accounting and appropriate disgorgement. The complaint also requests the court to impose civil penalties on the defendants. [SEC v. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE SOUTHERN COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by The Southern Company (Southern), a registered holding company, and Southern Nuclear Operating Company, Inc. (Southern Nuclear), a wholly owned subsidiary company of Southern. Southern Nuclear proposes to borrow from time to time through March 31, 1995 up to an aggregate principal amount of \$10 million from Southern or other lenders. (Rel. 35-25792)

METROPOLITAN EDISON COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Metropolitan Edison Company (Met-Ed) and Pennsylvania Electric Company (Penelec), both electric public-utility subsidiary companies of General Public Utilities Corporation, a registered holding company. Met-Ed and Penelec propose to enter into certain letter of credit repayment or reimbursement agreements with banks and deliver such letters of credit to the insurer for the purpose of securing their obligations in connection with job-related claims by the employees.
