SEC ANNOUNCES PENNY STOCK TASK FORCE CHIEF

The Commission today announced that Sarah B. Ackerson was named Chief of the Penny Stock Task Force, effective February 26, 1989. The Penny Stock Task Force is chaired by Joseph Goldstein, Associate Director, Division of Enforcement, and is part of the Division's Market Manipulation Program. The Task Force was formed in October 1988, under the leadership of David S. Ruder, Chairman of the Commission, to identify

problems posed by penny stock manipulation, to consider regulatory solutions and to educate investors on the risks of penny stock fraud. The Task Force is also working with other law enforcement agencies, state securities regulators and self-regulatory organizations to improve coordination and information sharing. Ms. Ackerson will coordinate efforts of the Task Force in this new position.

Until her new appointment, Ms. Ackerson was an Assistant Director in the Commission's Division of Market Regulation, with responsibility for Self Regulation Inspections. She assumed that position in 1984. Ms. Ackerson joined the Commission in 1977, as an attorney in the Division of Investment Management. (Press Release 89-19)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
