## **ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS**

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST HIEX DEVELOPMENT USA, INC.

The Commission entered an Order Instituting Proceedings, Making Findings, and Revoking the Registration of the common stock of Hiex Development USA, Inc. under Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Hiex, a firm doing business in Lakewood, Colorado, consented to the Order without admitting or denying the findings made therein. In the Order, the Commission found that Hiex failed to comply with Section 12(g) of the Exchange Act and Rule 12b-20 by filing a Form 10 which included financial statements not prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles. These financial statements materially overstate the carrying value of Hiex's assets and contain inaccurate and/or inadequate disclosures regarding certain transactions entered into by Hiex. In addition, the deficient Form 10 contained disclosure which did not comply with Items 303 and 102 of Regulation S-K under the Securities Act of 1933. The Commission had previously suspended trading in the common stock of Hiex for a ten-day period beginning June 20, 1988. (Rel. 34-26722)

RULE 2(e) PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST LYNNE K. MERCER

The Commission instituted an administrative proceeding under Rule 2(e) of its Rules of Practice and entered an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions against Lynne K. Mercer, a Salt Lake City-based certified public accountant licensed to practice in Utah. Mercer, while neither admitting nor denying the findings made therein, consented to the Order. The Commission found, among other things, that, in connection with Mercer's audits of Riex Development USA, Inc., Mercer certified financial statements which were not prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and performed an audit which did not comply with generally accepted auditing standards. These financial statements materially overstate the carrying value of Hiex's assets and contain inaccurate and/or inadequate disclosures regarding certain transactions entered into by Hiex. The Order denies Mercer the privilege of practicing before the Commission. After three years, Mercer may apply to resume practice upon a proper showing that he has met certain educational and professional association requirements. (Rel. 34-26723)

## **CIVIL PROCEEDINGS**

INVESTMENT MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATES AND MICHAEL R. BRYANT ENJOINED

The Atlanta Regional Office announced that on April 6 U.S. District Court Judge Robert H. Hall, Northern District of Georgia, issued a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Investment Management Associates and Michael R. Bryant of Roswell, Georgia, enjoining them from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act, Securities Exchange Act, and the Investment Advisers Act as well as certain recordkeeping requirements of the Advisers Act. Defendants consented to the Final Judgment without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint.

The Complaint alleges that IMA through Bryant issued a series of false account statements to its clients showing profits when in fact the accounts had suffered substantial losses. It also alleges that IMA charged clients advisory fees based on the false profits reported to its clients. In addition, Bryant acting for IMA allegedly made material misrepresentations and omissions of material facts to IMA's clients concerning, among other things, the investment of their funds, the expected returns thereon, the degree of risk undertaken by the investment strategy employed by IMA, and the security of their investments. It further alleges that IMA, aided and abetted by Bryant, failed to make and keep certain records required by the Advisers Act. (SEC v. Investment Management Associates and Michael R. Bryant, USDC NDGA, Civil Action No. 1:89-CV-670-RHH). (LR-12068)

## **INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

BOSTON FINANCIAL QUALIFIED HOUSING TAX CREDITS L.P. IV, A LIMITED PARTNERSHIP

An order has been issued on an application filed by Boston Financial Qualified Housing Tax Credits L.P. IV, A Limited Partnership (Partnership) and its managing general partner, Arch Street IV, Inc., exempting the Partnership from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. The Partnership will operate as a "two-tier" limited partnership by investing in other limited partnerships that in turn will engage in the development, rehabilitation, ownership, and operation of housing for low and moderate income persons. MERRILL LYNCH KECALP L.P. 1984

An order has been issued on an application filed by Merrill Lynch KECALP L.P. 1984, Merrill Lynch KECALP L.P. 1986 (together, Partnerships), and Merrill Lynch Interfunding Inc. (MLIF) exempting from the provisions of Section 17(a) of the Investment Company Act the acquisition of certain securities of PACE and MLIF, an affiliated person of the Partnerships. (Rel. ## **HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by The Columbia Gas System, Inc., a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, Columbia Gas Development of Canada Ltd., whereby Columbia will maintain the level of short-and long-term intrasystem financing for the subsidiary through 1989 as previously approved, but will acquire up to \$55 million of its common stock instead of acquiring the subsidiary's installment notes in the same principal amount.
