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## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

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### ORDER AFFIRMING FOIA OFFICER'S DETERMINATION

The General Counsel sent a letter to Mary Ann Werner, Esq., of the Washington Post, affirming the FOIA Officer's determination to deny access to certain transcripts of the investigatory testimony of Ivan F. Boesky. The General Counsel denied access under FOIA Exemption 7(A), 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(7)(A). (Rel. FOIA-114)

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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### QUEST FOR VALUE FAMILY OF FUNDS
