The Commission is hosting a roundtable on commission dollar practices and payments for order flow. The agenda will include topics such as the current nature and extent of the use of commission dollars to obtain research products; the effects of these commission dollar arrangements on execution liquidity and research availability; current disclosure practices concerning commission dollar practices; commission dollar arrangements employed by pension plan sponsors; the pervasiveness of payment for order flow practices; the economic incentives in connection with payment for order flow; and issues raised by payment for order flow arrangements. The participants will include representatives from the New York Stock Exchange, National Association of Securities Dealers, U.S. Department of Labor, U.K. Securities and Investments Board, and the broker-dealer, investment advisory, and banking communities. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

BRADLEY K. KOACH SANCTIONED

The Commission, in a previously instituted public administrative proceeding against Bradley H. Koach, a principal of a broker-dealer formerly registered with the Commission, accepted an Offer of Settlement from Koach wherein he consented to an Order Imposing Sanctions. The Order finds that Koach was permanently enjoined by the U.S. District Court for the District of Hawaii, on June 24, 1988, from violations of the antifraud and reporting provisions of the securities laws. The injunction was entered with Koach's consent. This matter arises out of Koach's participation in an alleged scheme involving the sales of at least \$16.8 million in interests in limited partnerships formed by FP Industries, Inc. to cultivate and market tropical foliage plants and orchids [see IR-1797].

The Order bars Koach from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser, or investment company, provided that he may apply to become so associated after the greater of five years from the date of the Order, or any period of incarceration, probation, or other penal sanction or parole that may be imposed upon him. In his Offer of Settlement, Koach consented to the Order without admitting or denying the allegations, except that he admitted the issuance of the permanent injunction. (Rel. 34-27034)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST WILLIAM H. KELLER AND GLOBAL INVESTMENT BROKERS, LIMITED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on June 26 Judge James B. Moran, Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division, entered Orders of Permanent Injunction against William H. Keller and Global Investment Brokers, Limited. The Orders enjoin defendants from future violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The Orders, entered by consent, provide that defendants disgorge monies received from the offer or sale of Global securities in the amount of \$179,000, plus interest.

The Complaint and an accompanying Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order, filed March 9, allege that from about 1987 to about March 1989, defendants offered and sold unregistered securities in the form of evidences of indebtedness or investment contracts to an unknown number of investors throughout the United States and claimed to have raised about \$1.4 million. The Complaint further alleges that defendants made material misrepresentations to investors concerning expected returns, the risks associated with the investment, and the tax-free nature of income from the investment. (SEC v. Global Investment Brokers, Limited, et al., USDC NDIL, Civil Action No. 89 C 1946). (LR-12164)

FINAL JUDGMENT OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST LEONARD MEYERS

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announced that on June 27 U.S. District Judge Jose A. Gonzalez, Jr., Southern District of Florida, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction, Order Requiring An Accounting and Other Relief against Leonard Meyers of Lantana, Florida. The Final Judgment enjoins Meyers from future violations of the antifraud and broker-dealer registration provisions of the securities laws, freezes his assets, requires him to file an accounting of the fraudulent condition of his and all entities under his control, and orders him to disgorge an amount of money to be determined at a later hearing.

Meyers consented to the Final Judgment without admitting or denying the allegations in the May 26 Complaint, which alleged that since at least May 1985, Meyers acted as an unregistered broker-dealer. Further, since at least May 1987, Meyers defrauded at least 12 investors of \$245,000, by misrepresenting that their funds would be invested in shares of mutual funds when Meyers actually converted the investors' funds to his own use. Meyers concealed his fraud by providing to investors phony statements, memoranda, and forged letters on Commission letterhead. (SEC v. Leonard Meyers, USDC SDFL, Civil Action No. 89-8244-CIV-GONZALEZ). (LR-12165)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE EQUITABLE TRUST

An order has been issued granting The Equitable Trust exemptions from Sections 13(a)(2), 18(f)(1), 22(f), and 22(g) of the Investment Company Act and approving certain transactions to permit the Trust to implement a deferred compensation plan for its trustees. (Rel. IC-17072 - July 19)

NORTH AMERICAN SECURITY LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued exempting North American Security Life Insurance Company, NASL Variable Account, NASL Financial Services, Inc., and Wood Logan Associates, Inc. from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from the assets of the Account. (Rel. IC-17073 - July 19)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

COLUMBUS SOUTHERN POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Columbus Southern Power Company (CSPC), subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc., to sell to CSPC's industrial customer, Fisher Guide Division - General Motors Corporation, for a purchase price of \$560,736 in cash, certain transformation equipment, and other related equipment located at CSPC's GM Substation No. 63 in Columbus, Ohio. (Rel. 35-24926 - July 18)

(Rel. 34-27035); and The Depository Trust Company, Midwest Clearing Corporation, Midwest Securities Trust Company, National Securities Clearing Corporation, Options Clearing Corporation, Philadelphia Depository Trust Company, and Stock Clearing Corporation (SR-DTC-88-20, SR-MCC-88-10, SR-MSTC-88-7, SR-NSCC-88-9, SR-OCC-89-2, SR-Philadelp-89-1, and SR-SCCP-89-1) to create the Securities Clearing Group and facilitate communication and coordination among registered clearing agencies.
