COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

AGENDA FOR PUBLIC HEARINGS ON NYSE'S "ONE SHARE, ONE VOTE" RULE

The Commission today announced the participants and agenda for its public hearings on the New York Stock Exchange's proposed rule change to modify its "one share, one vote" rule. The public hearings are to be held on December 16, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., and December 17, from 9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., in the Commission Meeting Room, Room 1C30, 450 Fifth Street, NW, Washington, DC. (Press Release 86-77)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

STOP ORDER ISSUED AS TO REGISTRATION STATEMENT OF BALSA DONDE USA, INC.

The Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings under Section 8(d) of the Securities Act of 1933, and Findings and Stop Order on December 9, suspending the effectiveness of a registration statement filed on May 23, and amended on September 5, by Balsa Donde USA, Inc. Balsa Donde consented to the Order without admitting or denying the findings contained therein.

In the Order, the Commission found that Balsa Donde's registration statement contains untrue statements of material facts and omits to state material facts required to be stated therein or necessary to make the statements therein not misleading. Specifically, the registration statement falsely stated that Balsa Donde is the sole supplier of remote piloted vehicle airframe component parts to Israel Aircraft Industries (IAI), and contained misleading statements regarding the likelihood of Balsa Donde's obtaining a \$1.25 million contract with IAI. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

FINAL JUDGMENTS ENTERED AGAINST BALSA DONDE USA, INC. AND ARYE DONDE

The Commission filed a complaint on December 9 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia, seeking Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction enjoining Balsa Donde USA, Inc., a Delaware corporation with manufacturing facilities located in Israel, and its chief operating officer, vice president, and director, Arye Donde, from violating certain antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933. The defendants consented to the Final Judgments without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint.

The complaint alleged that Balsa Donde filed with the Commission a registration statement on May 23, and an amended registration statement on September 5, which contained false and misleading statements of material facts regarding both Balsa Donde's status as sole supplier of airframe component parts for the Israel Aircraft Industries (IAI) and the likelihood of IAI's awarding Balsa Donde a \$1.25 million contract for those parts. The complaint also alleges that Donde supplied the information concerning Balsa Donde's sole supplier status and the \$1.25 million contract. Had either defendant taken steps to determine the accuracy of the representations, they would have learned that the representations were false. (SEC v. Balsa Donde USA, Inc. and Arye Donde, a/k/a Arik Donde, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 86-3373). (LR-11303)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

FREEDOM INVESTMENT TRUST

An order has been issued amending an existing Commission order by Freedom Investment Trust dated May 28. The amended order will allow Applicant to assess a contingent deferred sales load on its other series and to waive, defer, or reduce such charge in certain circumstances. (Rel. IC-15455 - Dec. 4)

NORWEST COLLECTIVE INVESTMENT TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 29 to request a hearing on an application of Norwest Collective Investment Trust for an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-15456 - Dec. 4)

JEFFERSON STANDARD LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 26 to request a hearing on an application by Jefferson Standard Life Insurance Company/Pilot Life Insurance Company, et al., for an order exempting from Section 17(a) of the Investment Company Act, to the extent necessary, the proposed merger of Jefferson Standard Separate Account A and Pilot Separate Account A. (Rel. IC-15457 - Dec. 4)

PHOENIX MUTUAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued granting Phoenix Mutual Life Insurance Company, et al., exemptions from Sections 2(a)(32), 22(c), 26(a)(2), 27(c)(1), 27(c)(2) and 27(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 6e-3(T)(b)(12), 6e-3(T)(b)(13) and 22c-1 to permit the deduction of an administrative charge and the premium tax in the form of a contingent deferred charge, in connection with the issuance of flexible premium variable life insurance contracts. (Rel. IC-15458 - Dec. 1)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

FLORIDA GAS TRANSMISSION COMPANY; PENNZOIL COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until December 22 to request a hearing on an application by the following companies filed under Release 35-24251, dated November 28: Florida Gas Transmission Company - subsidiary of Citrus Corporation, both Delaware corporations, for an order declaring that it is not a "gas utility company" under Section 2(a)(4) of the Public Utility Holding Company Act; and Pennzoil Company - and its subsidiary, Pennzoil Products Company (PPC), for an order declaring PPC not to be a gas utility company for purposes of the Public Utility Holding Company Act.

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The American Stock Exchange, Inc. filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-Amex-86-29) to amend the criteria for the original listing of securities and to amend suspension and delisting criteria. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of December 8. (Rel. 34-23863)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved the following proposed rule changes filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc.: (SR-NASD-86-29) amending Article III, Section 28, of its Rules of Fair Practice to impose disclosure requirements on NASD members' associated persons who maintain securities accounts with non-NASD members such as investment adviser, banks, and other financial institutions. (Rel. 34-23866); and (SR-NASD-86-28) amending its by-laws to preclude members of the Board of Governors who are absent from Board meetings from voting by proxy on issues before the Board. (Rel. 34-23867)
