THE UNION CENTRAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A rule change filed by The Options Clearing Corporation has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (SR-OCC-85-3) enabling OCC Clearing Members to use its Clearing Member Trade Assignment System on any exchange, even if the Clearing Member using the System is an exchange member. APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by The Chicago Board Options Exchange, Inc. (SR-CBOE-85-9) to amend its Rule 6.2, Interpretation .01, to reverse the order of the opening rotation for individual equity options. (Rel. 34-22042)

AMENDED PROPOSED RULE CHANGE
