ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST THOMAS H. WILSON AND C. FRANKLIN POLLARD

The Commission instituted and settled administrative proceedings against Thomas H. Wilson and C. Franklin Pollard, Jr., certified public accountants. The defendants consented, without admitting or denying staff allegations, to findings that they engaged in improper professional conduct by not following generally accepted auditing standards in the 1980 and 1981 audits of Doughties Foods, Inc. The settlement provides that Wilson and Pollard: not practice or appear before the Commission for 90 days; complete certain auditing courses; and for 270 days, have all their SEC audit engagements specially reviewed by a partner not otherwise assigned to the engagement. DECISION REVOKING BROKER-DEALER REGISTRATION OF DEAN W. CLUFF AND IMPOSING BAR FINAL

The decision of an administrative law judge revoking the broker-dealer registration of Dean W. Cluff of Orem, Utah and barring him from association with any broker or dealer has become final.

According to the law judge's decision, from about July 1977 to April 1980, Cluff violated registration and antifraud provisions of the securities acts. Cluff unlawfully sold investment contracts in the form of "joint venture agreements" under which he invested customers' money in various options strategies that he selected. He falsely represented to investors that his options program would produce annual profits of up to 55% of their investments, that his program was safe and a "sure thing", and that there was very little risk. He concealed from investors the fact that he was continuously losing money from his options trading, and furnished investors with false quarterly reports showing that they were earning profits when in fact they were sustaining heavy losses. JOHN HANCOCK SUBSIDIARIES, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 22 to request a hearing on an application filed by John Hancock Subsidiaries (J.H. Subs), subsidiary of John Hancock Mutual Life Insurance Company, requesting an order exempting John Hancock Capital Corporation, subsidiary of J.H. BMC FUND, INC.

An order has been issued permitting BMC Fund, Inc., a registered closed-end investment company, to repurchase up to 5.7 percent of its shares from the Broyhill Foundation, an affiliated person of BMC. (Rel. IC-13970 - May 25)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NASD-84-5) to amend various provisions of Article III, Section 26, Subsections (k)(1), (k)(2), (k)(3) and (k)(6) of the Rules of Fair Practice to clarify that these provisions apply to the sale or distribution of investment company shares. The NASD is also amending subsection (k)(7) of Section 26 to clarify that as long as the member does not violate any of the specific provisions of subsection (k), the member may conduct the transactions enumerated in subsection (k)(7). Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of May 28. (Rel. 34-21003)
