RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

ADOPTION OF AMENDMENTS TO ITEM 401 OF REGULATION S-K

The Commission adopted amendments to Item 401 of Regulation S-K relating to the disclosure of certain legal proceedings information about management. The amendments add commodities proceedings to the legal proceedings required to be disclosed with respect to directors and executive officers and require new registrants to disclose the same type legal proceedings involving promoters and control persons that they must disclose with respect to directors and executive officers. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PORTER FINANCIAL SERVICES, INC. AND ROBERT BURR PORTER ENJOINED

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on August 2 Judge David O. Belew, Jr., U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas, entered orders of permanent injunction against Porter Financial Services, Inc., a registered investment adviser located in Dallas, Texas, and its president, Robert Burr Porter. The orders permanently enjoin the defendants from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. Porter Financial and Porter consented to the orders without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations, which was also filed on August 2.

The complaint alleges that: (1) from 1980 to 1983, the defendants raised approximately \$5.5 million from 160 investors, including advisory clients of Porter Financial, through the offer and sale of limited partnership interests and common stock; and (2) in the offer, sale and purchase of these securities, and in the investment advisory business of Porter Financial, the defendants made material misrepresentations concerning the use of investor proceeds, the risks associated with these investments, the value of clients' securities investments, the profits which clients could expect from their investments, and the true financial condition of Porter Financial. OIL AND GAS PROMOTERS ENJOINED

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on July 27 Judge A. Joe Fish, U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas, issued Orders of Permanent Injunction against Merle L. Matlock and Charles E. Forrer, both of Dallas, Texas. The Orders enjoin the defendants from future violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The defendants consented to the Orders without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations.

The February 1, 1982 complaint alleges that: since at least July 1, 1978, Matlock, Forrer and five corporate defendants offered and sold to the public in excess of \$11 million of limited partnership interests in partnerships formed for oil and gas exploration and subordinated debentures, in violation of the registration provisions; and the defendants violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws by misrepresenting and omitting to state material facts. (SEC v. Petrowest Incorporated, et al., CA File No. 3-82-0160G, USDC ND TX, Dallas Division). (LR-10483)

HOMEWOOD FINANCE CORPORATION
