## **ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS**

JOSEPH A. GERACI III BARRED

The Commission announced that Joseph A. Geraci III, a person associated with a broker or dealer, agreed to the institution and settlement of administrative proceedings against him through which he is barred from association with any broker-dealer, municipal securities dealer or investment company. (Rel. 34-21181)

## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PERMANENT INJUNCTION AND OTHER EQUITABLE RELIEF ENTERED AGAINST CECIL H. BUTCHER, JR. AND JAMES E. STEINER

The Atlanta Regional Office announced that on August 6 Judge Thomas G. Hull, U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Tennessee, Northern Division, issued a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Cecil H. Butcher, Jr. and James E. Steiner, former officials of the Southern Industrial Banking Corporation of Knoxville, Tennessee. Butcher and Steiner consented to the Permanent Injunction, which prohibits future violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws, without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations.

The Commission's January 26 complaint alleged that the defendants, in the sales of investment certificates, made misrepresentations of material facts about, among other things, the financial condition of Southern Industrial and the extent of transactions or loans between Southern Industrial, its officers, directors, shareholders and their families.

Earlier, on June 5, Judge Hull issued a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against David A. Crabtree, a former director of Southern Industrial.

The remaining defendant, David G. Payne, continues to litigate this matter. (SEC v. Cecil H. Butcher, Jr., et al., ED TN, Northern Division, Civil Action No. 3-84-83). (LR-10496)

TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER ENTERED AGAINST CHARLOTTE GARRITY, OTHERS

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on August 9 Judge Robert A. Grant, U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Indiana, South Bend Division, entered a Temporary Restraining Order against Charlotte Garrity and Edward Garrity, of South Bend, Indiana, and two of the corporations they organized and operated, Investments International and Executive I, II, III. The Order temporarily restrains the defendants from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws, and freezes their assets.

The August 9 complaint alleged that the defendants violated the: registration provisions of the Securities Act by selling securities in the form of investment contracts called "memberships" in Investments International and Executive I, II, III; and antifraud provisions of the securities laws by omitting to state material facts and misrepresenting material facts to investors. (SEC v. Charlotte and Edward Garrity, dba Investments International, and Charlotte and Edward Garrity, dba Executive I, II, III, ND IN, No. S 84-0484, filed August 9, 1984). (LR-10498)

### CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

#### CLARENCE ABRAMSON PLEADS GUILTY

Rudolph W. Guliani, U.S. Attorney for the Southern District of New York, and the New York Regional Office announced that on July 19 Clarence Abramson waived indictment and pled guilty before Judge Abraham D. Sofaer, U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York, to a one-count Information charging conspiracy to commit securities and mail fraud arising out of an insider trading scheme.

The Information charged that from February to November 1981, Abramson, plant super-intendent and manufacturing supervisory staff member for the New York financial printing concern of Bowne of New York City, Inc., conspired with others, including registered representatives in the securities industry, to trade in various securities on the basis of material, non-public information concerning planned acquisitions and takeovers prior to the public announcement of such deals. According to the Information, Abramson received \$3,200 as well as stock market advice as payment for the stolen information and his co-conspirators reaped in excess of \$500,000 in illegal profits. (U.S. v. Abramson, Cr. No. 84-487, SDNY). (LR-10497)

### MASSA'S AND SKINNER'S CONVICTIONS AFFIRMED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on August 6 the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Eighth Circuit affirmed the convictions of James Massa and Duane Skinner for their participation in a \$16 million embezzlement from Stix & Co. Inc., formerly a St. Louis brokerage firm.

Massa and Skinner had been convicted on all counts in a 43-count indictment which charged them with conspiracy, mail, wire and securities fraud. Massa, a Collins-ville, Illinois attorney, was sentenced to 20 years imprisonment and Skinner, an Illinois accountant, was sentenced to 12 years imprisonment. (U.S. v. James Massa, 82 277CR, ED Mo). (LR-10499)
