#### **ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS**

#### DON A. WILLIAMS SANCTIONED

The Commission entered Findings and an Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions against Don A. Williams, of Canton, Ohio. Williams was formerly associated with a broker-dealer registered with the Commission. The Commission's Order was entered following Williams' submission of an Offer of Settlement in which he: admitted that he was convicted on May 3, 1984 in Cleveland, Ohio of one count of the felony of mail fraud, in connection with the conversion of customer monies (U.S. v. Don A. Williams, CR 84-75, U.S.D.C., No. Dist. of Ohio); neither admitted nor denied the other allegations contained in the Order Instituting Proceedings; and consented to Findings of violations and the sanctions imposed.

In accordance with his consent, the Commission found that during the period from in or about March 1982 to in or about July 1983, Williams violated the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. Accordingly, the Commission barred Williams from association with any broker or dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment company or investment adviser. (Rel. 34-21325)

#### JACK R. DRIBEN SUSPENDED

The Commission announced the simultaneous institution and settlement of administrative proceedings against Jack R. Driben suspending him from association with any broker or dealer for a period of nine months. The administrative proceedings arise out of the entry of a permanent injunction against Driben on September 12, 1984. (See LR-10527 under "Civil Proceedings".) (Rel. 34-21326)

### CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

#### JACK R. DRIBEN ENJOINED

The Commission announced the entry of a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Jack R. Driben. The judgment, issued by U.S. District Judge David N. Edelstein in New York on September 12, permanently enjoins Driben, a registered representative of a securities broker-dealer, from violating the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws.

The Commission's complaint, filed on June 27, alleges that Driben, in concert with others, was involved in a scheme to manipulate the price of the securities of Cymaticolor Corporation, of Edison, New Jersey, whose shares were then being traded over-the-counter. Driben consented to the entry of the injunction without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations. (SEC v. Cymaticolor Corp., et al., 84 Civ. 4508, DNE, S.D.N.Y., June 27, 1984) (LR-10527)

DISTRIBUTION OF DISGORGED FUNDS TO INVESTORS IN OIL LEASEHOLDS

The New York Regional Office announced that under an Order of the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York approximately \$100,000 in disgorged funds were distributed to investors in fractional undivided interests in oil lease-holds or rights under a consent injunction agreed to by Gonave Development Corporation, a defendant in the action SEC v. McGuire (78 Civil 3169, CLB). The funds became available as a result of claims made on behalf of Gonave and investors in bankruptcy proceedings against the other defendants in the Commission's action. (SEC v. #### **ACQUISITIONS OF SECURITIES**

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent.
