# **INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

C-U FUNDING CORP.

An order has been issued exempting C-U Funding Corp. from all provisions of the Investment Company Act to permit it to issue and sell bonds and loan the proceeds as part of the long-term financing of an electric generating plant and related facilities of Colorado-Ute Electric Association, Inc. (Rel. IC-14278 - Dec. 18)

SEVEN STAR PARTNERS, LTD.

An order has been issued exempting Seven Star Partners, Ltd., a Florida limited partnership, from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-14279 - Dec. 18)

TORONTO-DOMINION HOLDINGS (U.S.A.), INC.

An order has been issued conditionally exempting Toronto-Dominion Holdings (U.S.A.), Inc. from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-14280 - Dec. 18)

STATE BANK OF VICTORIA

An order has been issued granting State Bank of Victoria, an Australian bank, and its subsidiary, S. B. Victoria Funding Inc., an exemption from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in their proposed issuance of commercial paper in the United States. (Rel. IC-14281 - Dec. 18)

## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

YANKEE ATOMIC ELECTRIC COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Yankee Atomic Electric Company, subsidiary of New England Electric System and Northeast Utilities, to issue and sell up to \$15 million of short-term notes to banks and/or commercial paper to dealers through December 31, 1986. (Rel. 35-23536 - Dec. 19)

#### EASTERN EDISON COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Eastern Edison Company, Blackstone Valley Electric Company, and Montaup Electric Company, subsidiaries of Eastern Utilities Associates, to issue short-term notes to banks in aggregate amounts outstanding at any one time not to exceed \$10 million in the case of Eastern Edison, \$30 million in the case of Montaup, and \$5 million in the case of Blackstone. AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY, INC.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing American Electric Power Company, Inc., a registered holding company, to modify the terms of its dividend reinvestment and stock purchase plan, including raising the price of the shares to 100% of the price on the New York Stock Exchange. ## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved proposed rule changes filed by: <u>The Pacific Stock Exchange</u>, <u>Inc.</u> (SR-PSE-84-18) to amend certain provisions of its pilot program for the apointment and evaluation of specialists and the creation of new specialist posts in its specialist post expansion program. The amendments modify existing rules and procedures on a temporary basis and only respecting the application for the approval of nine additional specialist posts which the PSE intends to add during the first quarter of 1985. (Rel. 34-21578); <u>The National Association of Securities Dealers</u>, Inc. (SR-NASD-84-27) modifying the present filing requirements of the Interpretation of the Board of Governors Review of Corporate Financing by exempting from filing requirements all debt and equity offerings of securities offered by a corporate, foreign government or foreign government agency issuer which has senior non-convertible debt or preferred securities rated by a nationally recognized statistical rating organization in one of its four highest generic rating categories. (Rel. 34-21585); <u>The Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board</u> (SR-MSRB-84-15) amending MSRB Rule G-12(h) to delay the "sunset" date for the close-out transfer extension provisions to January 1, 1986. (Rel. 34-21587)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
