## **INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

### JEFFERSON VILLAGE HOUSING PARTNERS

An order has been issued on an application by Jefferson Village Housing Partners (Partnership) and its general partner, Jefferson Village Management Corp., exempting the Partnership from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-14290 -Dec. 27)

### CAISSE NATIONALE DE CREDIT AGRICOLE

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 21, 1985 to request a hearing on an application filed by Caisse Nationale de Credit Agricole and its subsidiary, Credit Agricole U.S.A. Inc., for an order exempting them from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in the proposed issuance of commercial paper within the United States. (Rel. IC-14291 - Dec. 27)

### PRUDENTIAL-BACHE CALIFORNIA MUNICIPAL FUND

An order has been issued exempting Prudential-Bache California Municipal Fund and Prudential-Bache Municipal Series Fund from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 22c-1 to permit them to assess a contingent deferred sales load on certain redemptions of their respective initial and future series of shares, and to permit them to waive the contingent deferred sales load in specified circumstances. # HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### NORTHEAST UTILITIES

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 21, 1985 to request a hearing on a proposal by Northeast Utilities, a registered holding company, and its subsidiary regarding open account advances and capital contributions by The Connecticut Light and Power Company and its subsidiary, The Shelton Canal Company. (Rel. 35-23550 - Dec. 28)

### GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Georgia Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to issue first mortgage bonds for sinking fund purposes. (Rel. 35-23551 -Dec. 28)

### SOUTHWESTERN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Southwestern Electric Power Company, subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation, to sell three gas turbines which are not in operation and are not needed. (Rel. 35-23552 - Dec. 28)

### MIDDLE SOUTH UTILITIES INC.

An order has been issued authorizing Middle South Utilities, Inc., a registered holding company, to enter into a revolving credit agreement providing for the issuance and sale by Middle South of up to \$71.5 million of its unsecured promissory notes to a group of commercial banks. Jurisdiction has been reserved pending completion of the record over the issuance and sale of up to \$58.5 million of additional promissory notes. (Rel. 35-23553 - Dec. 28)

An order has been issued granting the application of the Pacific Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in the common stock of ten issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. # SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Chicago Board Options Exchange, Incorporated filed a proposed rule change which became effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-84-32) will eliminate the charge for services, under CBOE Rule 2.22, rendered by CBOE Order Book Officials on orders executed in the National Semiconductor class of option contracts. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the wek of December 31. (Rel. 34-21609)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Philadelphia Stock Exchange, Inc. filed the following proposed rule changes under Rule 19b-4: (SR-Phlx-84-33) that would allow Phlx member organizations to accept letters of credit to satisfy both initial and maintenance margin requirements for foreign currency options written and carried short in a customer's account for a pilot period of one year. (Rel. 34-21610); and (SR-Phlx-84-29) to adopt proposed Rule 1067, which provides that the highest bid and the lowest offer in options trading shall have precedence in all cases. (Rel. 34-21611)

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of December 31.

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
