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ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

U.S. SECURITIES AND
EXCHANGE COMMISSION

SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST PARHAM & COMPANY, INC. AND ROBERT GERALD PARHAM, JR.

The Commission announced that it has entered Findings and an Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions against Parham & Co., Inc. (PCI), a now defunct Little Rock, Arkansas broker-dealer, and Robert Gerald Parham, Jr., a resident of Little Rock and the former president of PCI, in connection with an administrative proceeding.

Under the terms of the Offers of Settlement, PCI and Parham admitted that they had been permanently enjoined from further violations of certain provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. In addition, without admitting or denying the other allegations contained in the Order for Proceedings, they consented to the findings of violations and the sanctions imposed.

In the Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions, the Commission found that on April 21, 1981, in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Arkansas, PCI and Parham were permanently enjoined by consent from further violations and aiding and abetting violations of the net capital, recordkeeping and notifications provisions of the Exchange Act. In addition, the Commission found that PCI and Parham wilfully violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Exchange Act.

The Commission's Order revoked PCI's broker-dealer registration. The Order also barred Parham from association with any broker-dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer, provided, however, that after a period of two years from the date of the Commission's Order, he could apply to the Commission to become associated with a regulated entity in a non-supervisory and non-proprietary capacity upon a showing of adequate supervision. APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission has approved proposed rule changes filed by the following: The Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-82-16) amending OCC Rule 308 to require participants to file annually with OCC specified types of financial information. (Rel. 34-19480); the Midwest Securities Trust Company (SR-MSTC-82-24); and the Midwest Clearing Corporation (SR-MCC-82-18) amending MSTC Rule 8, Section 2, and MCC Rule 14, Section 2 to provide that a broker-dealer applicant for membership or participant must have a minimum of \$50,000 in excess net capital over the requirement imposed by the broker-dealer's designed examining authority. (See generally 17 CFR §240.15c3-1) The proposals further require that non-broker-dealer applicants or participants meet and maintain compliance with the financial stability standards applicable to the industry with which those applicants and participants are associated. Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
