DECISIONS IN ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

CONTEMPORARY SECURITIES CORPORATION REVOKED; OTHERS BARRED

Contemporary Securities Corporation, a registered broker-dealer, John F. McCarthy, a former salesman in its San Diego branch office and Ted England, a former branch manager, trader and salesman in the Salt Lake City office of John Stephens & Company, failed to answer the order that instituted proceedings on September 29, 1976, and are therefore in default. Accordingly, the registration as a broker-dealer of Contemporary Securities Corporation has been revoked; and John F. McCarthy and Ted A. England have been barred from being associated with any broker-dealer. (Rel. 34-13261)

WALTER E. PARKER, OTHERS BARRED

The Commission has entered an order barring Walter E. Parker, Hubert E. Lay, and Gerald H. Lowther from association with a broker-dealer, investment adviser and investment company in the capacities specified in Section 9(b) of the Investment Company Act of 1940. In addition, Lay and Lowther, both practicing attorneys, submitted their voluntary resignations from appearance and practice before the Commission, which the Commission accepted. The sanctions were based on findings that Parker, Lay and Lowther, all former officers and/or directors of Founders of American Investment Corporation, a registered investment company, violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws and various provisions of the Investment Company Act of 1940. The Commission's action was taken pursuant to offers of settlement of Parker, Lowther and Lay in which the responsents, without admitting or denying the allegations in the order for proceedings, consented to the above findings and sanctions. COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

JUSTIM P. KLEIN NAMED DIRECTOR, OFFICE OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS

Chairman Roderick M. Hills today announced the appointment of Justin P. Klein as Director of the Office of Consumer Affairs.

Mr. Klein joined the Commission in February, 1974 as a staff attorney in the Division of Market Regulation. In February, 1976 he was named Acting Branch Chief for the Branch of Compliance and Examinations and more recently was named a full Branch Chief.

He is a graduate of the University of Pennsylvania and received his J.D. in June, 1972 from the George Washington University Law School, with honors. Prior to joining the Commission, Mr. Klein practiced law in Washington, D.C. He is a member of the Bars of the State of Maryland and the District of Columbia.

Mr. Klein also brings with him to the Office experience in the consumer field. In 1971-1972 he was the Director of the Consumer Protection Center, which is affiliated with George Washington University Law School. In addition, he has served as a Visiting Assistant Lecturer in Law at the George Washington University Law School and in this capacity taught "Problems of the Consumer."

As one of his primary duties as Director of the Office of Consumer Affairs, Mr. Klein will make recommendations to the Commission on the establishment of a nationwide system for the resolution of investor disputes. Mr. Klein will continue to explore the possibilities of improving the Commission's consumer protection program as set forth in the Commission's release of May 20, 1976.

COURT ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS

INDICTMENT AGAINST KENT M. KLINEMAN DISMISSED

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on February 7 on motion of the Department of Justice, an indictment against Kent M. Klineman, New York, New York, was dismissed.

On December 21, 1976, Federal District Judge Allen E. Barrow at Tulsa, Oklahoma, sentenced Robert S. Trippet, Frank E. Sims, and Harry L. Fitzgerald, all of Tulsa, to three years probation, a fine of \$19,000 and a requirement to deposit \$100,000 in an investors' restitution fund; one year probation and a requirement to deposit \$5,000 in the restitution fund; and one year unsupervised probation, respectively. Sentencing followed pleas of nolo contendere by Trippet and Sims to one count of conspiracy and nine counts of mail fraud in the sale of securities. Fitzgerald initially entered a plea of guilty to two counts of illegal sale of securities, but later was allowed to change his guilty plea to nolo contendere.

On December 15, 1976, Judge Barrow granted a motion for acquittal on all counts for Norman C. Cross, Tulsa, who had been charged earlier on February 20, 1976, in a tencount indictment consisting of conspriacy to violate the securities, tax, and mail fraud statutes, and nine counts of mail fraud by a federal grand jury at Tulsa.
