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COURT ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS

U.S. CELLANT ES AND

SINCERO OIL & GAS CO., THOMAS F. SINCIRO ENJOINED

EXCHANCE COMMISSION

The Fort Worth Regional Office and the Houston Branch Office announced that on March 21 the Federal District Court at Houston, Texas entered orders of permanent injunction prohibiting Sincero Oil & Gas Co. and Thomas F. Sinciro, both of Houston, from violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws in the offer and sale of fractional undivided working interests in oil and gas leases issued by Sincero Oil & Gas Co. The defendants consented to the entry of the orders of permanent injunction without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint which was filed on February 15. (SEC v. Sincero Oil & Gas Co., et al., S.D. Tex., Civil Action No. A-77-260). (LR-7852)

STEPHEN KNEAPLER, OTHERS ENJOINED

The Atlanta Regional Office and the Miami Branch Office announced that on March 25 the Honorable James L. King, U.S. District Judge for the Southern District of Florida signed final judgments of permanent injunction enjoining Stephen Kneapler, Harvey Fein, Jerome Shishko, Alberto Gross and Bruce Flamm from violating the antifraud, periodic filing and proxy provisions of the securities laws in the securities of Richford Industries, Inc. or any other securities. The defendants consented to the entry of the judgments without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the Commission's complaint. (SEC v. Stephen Kneapler, et al., S.D. Fla., Civil Action No. 77-969-JLK). (LR-7854)
