## **RULES AND RELATED MATTERS**

LIBRARY

RULE 206A-1(T) EXTENDED

The Commission announced the extension until April 30, 1978 of the temporary exemption from the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 (Advisers Act) provided by Rule 206A-(T) under the Advisers Act. The rule exempts any broker-dealer registered on May 1, 1975 pursuant to Section 15 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, not then registered as an investment adviser pursuant to Section 203 of the Advisers Act and who does not provide investment supervisory services or investment management services for special compensation or not solely incidental to his business as a broker-dealer. ### **COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS**

COMMISSION ISSUES ALERT TO CORPORATIONS

The Commission has issued a release alerting issuers of publicly held securities that they may be receiving bills for fees for the mailing of their annual reports and other communications from persons who are not shareholders of record and do not otherwise represent beneficial owners of securities of the corporation. Frequently, such bills are for services which were never requested and which may be of only marginal value to the corporation. (Rel. 34-13455)

## **INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

MONTGOMERY STREET INCOME SECURITIES
