brief summary of financial proposals filed with and actions by the S.E.C.

XEROX FILES FOR SECONDARY. Xerox Corporation, 700 Midtown Tower, Rochester, N. Y. 14604, filed a registration statement (File 2-23733) with the SEC on June 22 seeking registration of 100,000 outstanding shares of common stock. The stock may be offered for public sale by the holder thereof, Wesleyan University, through transactions on the New York Stock Exchange or in the over-the-counter market, and at prices prevailing at the time of sale (\$1332 per share maximum\*).

The company is engaged , sacipally in the manufacture and marketing of products for xerographic and photocopy reproduction and for photographic use. In addition to indebtedness, it has outstanding 20,681,518 common shares, of which management officials own approximately 3%. The selling stockholder, Wesleyan University, is to acquire 400,000 of the company's common shares on July 1 in exchange for certain assets and educational publishing activities (known as American Education Publications) of the University and The Wesleyan University Press Incorporated, a non-stock corporation formed and operated to serve educational purposes of the University. Sol M. Linowitz is board chairman of the company and Joseph C. Wilson is president.

EASTERN AIR LINES FILES FOR SECONDARY. Eastern Air Lines, Inc., 10 Rockefeller Plaza, New York 10020, filed a registration statement (File 2-23732) with the SEC on June 22 seeking registration of \$10,000,000 of outstanding 5-3/8% convertible junior subordinated debentures due 1983. The debentures, or 400,000 shares of common stock issuable upon the conversion thereof, may be offered for public sale by the present holders through transactions on the New York or Midwest Stock Exchange at market prices prevailing at the time of sale.

In addition to indebtedness, the company has outstanding 3,665,952 common shares, of which management officials own 1.41%. The prospectus lists 17 selling debentureholders, including The Colonial Fund, Inc., Morgan Guaranty Trust Co. of New York, as agent for Laurance S. Rockefeller, and Morgan Guaranty Trust Company of New York, as agent for Yale University, each offering \$1,000,000 of debentures; and Puritan Fund, Inc., \$2,200,000. The remaining selling debentureholders are offering debentures ranging in amounts from \$150,000 to \$600,000. The selling debentureholders are offering their entire debenture holdings. According to the prospectus, the debentures were acquired by the present holders on June 1, 1965, pursuant to exchange provisions contained in \$22,000,000 of 5-3/8% convertible junior subordinated notes issued by the company in November 1963. F. D. Hall is president of the company. (Two other proposed secondary offerings of Eastern's securities are summarized in SEC News Digest of June 17 and 21.)

COLUMBIA GAS RECEIVES SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER. The SEC has issued a supplemental order under the Holding Company Act (Release 35-15267) authorizing additional transactions by The Columbia Gas Company in connection with its application for an order permitting it to acquire some \$62,650,000 of installment notes from 15 subsidiaries through March 1966, to purchase \$5,300,000 of additional common stock from three subsidiaries, and to make open-account advances aggregating \$80,000,000 during 1965 to five subsidiaries. By Commission order of April 26, 1965, certain of the proposals were authorized. The Commission has now granted further authorization for Columbia Gas to sell an aggregate of \$16,200,000 of installment notes to five of its subsidiaries and to acquire 16,000 shares of common stock of another subsidiary, The Preston Oil Co., at the Par value of \$1,600,000. The proceeds therefrom are to be applied to the subsidiaries' construction programs. The Commission has also authorized the parent to make open-account advances to United Fuel Gas Company \*8gregating \$21,000,000, to be used for the purchase of current inventory gas.

UNLISTED TRADING GRANTED. The SEC has issued an order under the Securities Exchange Act (Release 34-7630) granting an application of the Philadelphia-Baltimore-Washington Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in the common stock of General Aniline & Film Corporation.

TWO STOCKS DELISTED. The SEC has issued an order under the Securities Exchange Act (Release 34-7630) granting an application of the Midwest Stock Exchange to strike from listing and registration the common stock of Packaging Corporation of America, effective at the opening of business on June 24. The application states that, pursuant to a Plan of Reorganization, the company has exchanged its stock for common stock of Tennessee Gas Transmission Co. The Commission has also issued an order granting an application of the New  $_{
m York}$  Stock Exchange to delist the Class A stock and 447 convertible subordinated debentures of  $_{
m Yale}$  Express System, Inc., effective at the opening of business on June 29. The company on May 21, 1965, filed a petition in the U. S. District Court for the Southern District of New York for reorganization under Chapter X of the Federal Bankruptcy Act.

TRADING IN IDAMONT OIL SUSPENDED: INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED. The SEC today announced the issuance of an order under the Securities Exchange Act temporarily suspending over-the-counter trading in the capital stock of Idamont Oil and Mining Company ("Idamont Oil") for the ten-day period June 23 to July 2, 1965, inclusive. The suspension also applies to certain fractional undivided interests and investment contracts relating to Idamont Oil's mining properties, and options to acquire such stock and interests.

OVER

In a related action, the SEC Seattle Regional Office filed an action in the U. S. District Court in Billings, Montana, seeking to enjoin the further offering and sale of such securities in violation of the registration and anti-fraud provisions of the Securities Act. Named as defendants, in addition to Idamont Oil, were the following: Kenneth D. Saunders, J. Earl Johnson, Lawrence Johnson, Albert Berndt, Parker-Hayes & Company, C. William Parker, Charles Hayes, Raymond C. Nelson, Leroy Wells and Melvin A. Pederson.

CORRECTION RE BELOCK INSTRUMENTS. By order of June 22, the SEC temporarily suspended trading in the common and preferred stocks of Belock Instrument Corp., as well as its Series A and Series B 6% convertible subordinated debentures, both due 1975. The SEC News Digest of June 22 announcing the suspension omitted reference to the preferred stock and Series B debentures.

RELEASE ON "AIR & SPACE UNDERWRITERS, OTHERS CITED" should carry the release number of LR-3251, instead of LR-3252 as reported in SEC News Digest of June 22.
