1 Name two rules you should follow as a pedestrian.	Choose from: • wear bright colored clothes • walk on a sidewalk if one is present • walk facing traffic if a sidewalk is not present • use a flashlight at night • walk don't run when crossing the street • always hold a child's hand when crossing the street or in a parking lot • cross the street at a corner or in a crosswalk • walk with others • children shouldn't walk after dark • stop at the edge of a street or driveway and look left-right-left for traffic before crossing
2 What should you always do before riding your bicycle?	Put on and buckle your helmet
3 What should you always do before crossing the street?	Stop at the curb or edge of the road and look left-right-left for traffic. Cross when no traffic is present.

5 Name two bike safety rules.	 Choose from: act like a vehicle on the roadway follow all the same rules of the road as motorized vehicles always wear a bicycle helmet always make sure your family and friends wear a bicycle helmet every time they ride ride in the same direction as motorized traffic do not ride on sidewalks where it is not permitted wear bright colors during the day so others can see you wear reflective materials in low light conditions (dusk, dawn, fog, rain, etc.) children should not ride bicycles at night — if they must, then use a white front light.

9	Name something to consider when selecting a safe route to school.	Choose from among routes that have: • sidewalks present • pedestrian crossings, signals, or school crossing guards • streets with lower speeds • few lanes to cross • a refuge island • wide shoulders if no sidewalk is present Avoid routes that include walking through or around vacant lots or buildings.
10	What side of the road should you walk on if a sidewalk is not available?	If a sidewalk is not available, always walk on the left side of the street (or facing traffic)
1	Left without your bicycle helmet fastened, go back home and adjust your helmet properly.	Not applicable.
12	Name a way you can set a good example as a bicyclist.	Examples include: • wear a properly fitted bicycle helmet every ride • obey traffic signs and signals • give pedestrians the right of way or yield to pedestrians • ride in the same direction as motorized traffic • obey pedestrian signals if crossing the street in a crosswalk
13	Name a way you can set a good example as a pedestrian.	Examples include: • wait for the signal to change or walk with the pedestrian signal • always walk on the sidewalk if one is present • walk facing traffic if a sidewalk is not present • encourage your friends to follow safe pedestrian behavior • look left-right-left for traffic before crossing a street • look for traffic while crossing the street • hold children's hands when crossing the street
14	Who should follow pedestrian rules?	Everyone who walks around motorized traffic (cars, trucks, buses, and motorcycles) and non-motorized traffic (other people walking, bicycles, those on skates, skateboards, etc.) should watch out for others and follow the rules to keep themselves safe.
15	True or False? Bicyclists should follow the same rules of the road as motorists.	True. Bicyclists are considered vehicles and should follow the same rules of the road as motorized vehicles. Rules include: riding in the same direction as traffic, obeying all traffic signs and signals, and being courteous to other road users.
