MNA's DWDM technology can currently support up to 40 lambdas of 10Gbps wavelengths and can be upgraded to support 40Gbps wavelengths. As a mature and profitable "middle mile" provider we belive that the "middle mile" applicants within our service areas are trying to duplicate existing networks like ours simply for their self-centered competitive initiatives. Our "principal centered position" is that Missouri already has a sufficient number of high capacity, experienced and solid "middle mile" service providers ("as the just released Insight's Broadband Competition Research Report confirms").
