Executive Order 13582 of August 17, 2011 Blocking Property of the Government of Syria and Prohibiting Certain Transactions With Respect to Syria

## **GENERAL LICENSE NO. 14**

## Transactions Related to Telecommunications Authorized

- (a) All transactions with respect to the receipt and transmission of telecommunications involving Syria are authorized provided that no payment pursuant to this general license may involve (1) any debit to an account of the Government of Syria on the books of a U.S. financial institution, or (2) any transaction with a person other than the Government of Syria whose property and interests in property are blocked pursuant to Executive Order 13338 of May 11, 2004, Executive Order 13399 of April 25, 2006, Executive Order 13460 of February 13, 2008, Executive Order 13572 of April 29, 2011, Executive Order 13573 of May 18, 2011, or Executive Order 13582 of August 17, 2011.
  - (b) This general license does not authorize:
  - (1) the provision, sale, or lease to the Government of Syria or to a person in Syria of telecommunications equipment or technology; or
  - (2) the provision, sale, or lease of capacity on telecommunications transmission facilities (such as satellite or terrestrial network connectivity) to Syria.
