Fort Belvoir, VA – The Defense Technical Information Center (DTIC) sponsors the DoD Congressional Budget Data and Congressional Budget Data Query websites, available through DTIC Online Public (DOP) and DTIC Online Access Controlled (DOAC) respectively.

The DoD Congressional Budget Data website http://www.dtic.mil/congressional budget/ allows visitors to access DoD Congressional Budget data in both PDF and Excel spreadsheets. The reports are broken down into four categories; Research, Development, Test and Engineering (RDT&E); Procurement; Operations and Maintenance (O&M); and Personnel. The information on this site is based on the authoritative information found on the Library of Congress legislative website, called Thomas http://www.thomas.gov.

The DoD Congressional Budget Query site https://www.dtic.mil/congressional/index.html allows users to query the President's Budget Request (PBR) data and the Congressional Marks data for Fiscal Years 2005-2013. Congress "marks" the PBR data six times before the budget becomes Public Law. This information is sourced from the DoD Comptroller Defense Budget Materials website for the PBR and Congressional websites for the marked reports. To access the DoD Congressional Budget Query site through DOAC, you must be a DTIC Registered User. To register, please visit https://www.dtic.mil.

In addition to the DoD Congressional Budget Query site, DOAC also contains the Research, Development, Descriptive Summaries (RDDS) (R-2s) and the RDT&E Budget Data.
