UNITED STATES AND JAPAN TO NEGOTIATE AMENDMENTS TO INCOME TAX TREATY

WASHINGTON – The U.S. Department of the Treasury announced today that it plans to begin formal negotiation of amendments to the existing bilateral income tax treaty with Japan, which entered into force in 2004. The first formal round of negotiations will take place June 8-10, 2011 in Washington. The negotiations will aim to bring the existing tax treaty into closer conformity with the current tax treaty policies of the United States and Japan.
