- 2. The following definitions of terms used in this Report:
 - a. **Administrative Appeal** a request to a federal agency asking that it review at a higher administrative level a FOIA determination made by the agency at the initial request level.
 - b. **Average Number** the number obtained by dividing the sum of a group of numbers by the quantity of numbers in the group. For example, of 3, 7, and 14, the average number is 8.
 - c. **Backlog** the number of requests or administrative appeals that are pending at an agency at the end of the fiscal year that are beyond the statutory time period for a response.
 - d. **Component** for agencies that process requests on a decentralized basis, a "component" is an entity, also sometimes referred to as an Office, Division, Bureau, Center, or Directorate, within the agency that processes FOIA requests. The FOIA now requires that agencies include in their Annual FOIA Report data for both the agency overall and for each principal component of the agency.
 - e. **Consultation** the procedure whereby the agency responding to a FOIA request first forwards a record to another agency for its review because that other agency has an interest in the document. Once the agency in receipt of the consultation finishes its review of the record, it responds back to the agency that forwarded it. That agency, in turn, will then respond to the FOIA requester.
 - f. **Exemption 3 Statute** a federal statute that exempts information from disclosure and which the agency relies on to withhold information under subsection (b)(3) of the FOIA.

- g. **FOIA Request** a FOIA request is generally a request to a federal agency for access to records concerning another person (i.e., a "third-party" request), or concerning an organization, or a particular topic of interest. FOIA requests also include requests made by requesters seeking records concerning themselves (i.e., "first-party" requests) when those requesters are not subject to the Privacy Act, such as non-U.S. citizens. Moreover, because all first-party requesters should be afforded the benefit of both the access provisions of the FOIA as well as those of the Privacy Act, FOIA requests also include any first-party requests where an agency determines that it must search beyond its Privacy Act "systems of records" or where a Privacy Act exemption applies, and the agency looks to FOIA to afford the greatest possible access. All requests which require the agency to utilize the FOIA in responding to the requester are included in this Report. Additionally, a FOIA request includes records referred to the agency for processing and direct response to the requester. It does not, however, include records for which the agency has received a consultation from another agency. (Consultations are reported separately in Section XII of this Report.)
- h. **Full Grant** an agency decision to disclose all records in full in response to a FOIA request
- i. **Full Denial** an agency decision not to release any records in response to a FOIA request because the records are exempt in their entireties under one or more of the FOIA exemptions, or because of a procedural reason, such as when no records could be located.
- j. **Glomar Response** An instance where the Department of Veterans Affairs will not confirm or deny the existence of the records requested.
- k. **Median Number** the middle, not average, number. For example, of 3, 7, and 14, the median number is 7.
- l. **Multi-Track Processing** a system in which simple requests requiring relatively minimal review are placed in one processing track and more voluminous and complex requests are placed in one or more other tracks. Requests granted expedited processing are placed in yet another track. Requests in each track are processed on a first in/first out basis.
 - i. **Expedited Processing** an agency will process a FOIA request on an expedited basis when a requester satisfies the requirements for expedited processing as set forth in the statute and in agency regulations.
 - ii. **Simple Request** a FOIA request that an agency using multi-track processing places in its fastest (non-expedited) track based on the low volume and/or simplicity of the records requested.
 - iii. **Complex Request** a FOIA request that an agency using multi-track processing places in a slower track based on the high volume and/or complexity of the records requested.
- m. **Partial Grant/Partial Denial** in response to a FOIA request, an agency decision to disclose portions of the records and to withhold other portions that are exempt under the FOIA, or to otherwise deny a portion of the request for a procedural reason.

- n. **Pending Request or Pending Administrative Appeal** a request or administrative appeal for which an agency has not taken final action in all respects.
- o. **Perfected Request** a request for records which reasonably describes such records and is made in accordance with published rules stating the time, place, fees (if any) and procedures to be followed.
- p. **Processed Request or Processed Administrative Appeal** a request or administrative appeal for which an agency has taken final action in all respects.
- q. **Range in Number of Days** the lowest and highest number of days to process requests or administrative appeals.
- r. **Time Limits** the time period in the statute for an agency to respond to a FOIA request (ordinarily twenty working days from receipt of a perfected FOIA request.
- 3. FOIA Exemptions. VA must disclose records under the FOIA unless the information requested is protected under one or more of FOIA's explicit exemptions. These exemptions apply if the requested information falls within one of the following categories:
 - a. Exemption 1: classified national defense and foreign relations information
 - b. Exemption 2: internal agency rules and practices
 - c. **Exemption 3**: information that is prohibited from disclosure by another federal law
 - d. Exemption 4: trade secrets and other confidential business information
 - e. Exemption 5: inter-agency or intra-agency communications that are protected by legal privileges
 - f. Exemption 6: information involving matters of personal privacy
 - g. Exemption 7: records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, to the extent that the production of those records (A) could reasonably be expected to interfere with enforcement proceedings, (B) would deprive a person of a right to a fair trial or an impartial adjudication, (C) could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, (D) could reasonably be expected to disclose the identity of a confidential source, (E) would disclose techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or (F) could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of any individual
 - h. Exemption 8: information relating to the supervision of financial institutions
 - i. Exemption 9: geological information on wells

Note to Readers

I. Data Used in this Year's Report

The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) Annual FOIA Report for 2008 was prepared in accordance with the 2008 Guidelines for Agency Preparation of Annual FOIA Reports, Office of Information and Privacy, U.S. Department of Justice, May 2008. This year's guidelines revised the required content and format of this Report as compared with those of previous years. Most significantly, the data contained in the 2008 Report is **limited to data on FOIA requests only**. Privacy Act (PA) requests are included only if the FOIA was used in any way to process the request, i.e., if the search extended beyond a PA "system of records" (see 5 U.S.C. § 552a(a)(5) (2006)), or if an access determination based on FOIA needed to be made subsequent to a PA exemption. Where the agency conducted a PA search exclusively (i.e., within a "system of records") and did not claim a PA exemption for any records located, those requests are not included in this Report.

Consequently, the 2008 Annual Report should not and cannot be compared to the 2007 Report or any other report, which contained data on both PA and FOIA requests. The final numbers in the 2007 and 2008 Reports do not correlate with each other; for instance, the 2007 Report closed the year with 35,366 pending requests (see Section V.A.), which consisted of both FOIA and PA requests. In the 2008 Report, VA reports opening the year with 5,101 requests. This discrepancy of 30,265 requests is attributable to the exclusion of PA requests.

In addition, the new reporting requirements were issued when the reporting period was underway. VA's FOIA activities are decentralized, and it was therefore not possible to incorporate all the new reporting requirements in time for the preparation of the 2008 Report. As a result, the integrity of the data reported in this year's Report is limited by the lack of an automated and department-wide system to separate PA requests from FOIA requests with 100% accuracy. Likewise, because of the lack of automation, the total number in the table for Section VII(C) of this Report (pp. 16 and 17) does not equal the total number of processed requests because requests may have been counted more than once in each section of the Report. Lacking an automated method in which to generate the Report has contributed to the discrepancy in totals that should, in theory, be the same.

VA has acquired and is implementing an automated FOIA tracking system that will be used department-wide and should address these discrepancies in next year's Report.

II. Principal Components of the Agency

Attention is drawn to the Offices that are named as principal components of the Agency. Under the Department of Justice's guidance (May 2008), VA is presenting the report data of 26 offices that are considered principal components for purposes of this report. The named offices differ from last year's report only in that two offices have been removed, and one office has been added. Specifically:

- the Board of Contract Appeals has been removed from the list, as it was dissolved on January 7, 2007;
- the Office of Information Technology Support Service was removed from the list because requests it receives are processed by the FOIA Officer for the Office of Information and Technology; and
- The Office of Construction and Facilities Management was added to the list.

F. Discussion of Other FOIA Activities (Optional)

During fiscal year 2008 VA engaged in multiple efforts aimed at developing a more robust and streamlined FOIA program.

For example, in the area of outreach and education, VA trained a record number of FOIA Officers by conducting FOIA training throughout the year. Training material was developed to train over 300 FOIA Officers; the lead attorneys on FOIA from the Department of Justice were invited to VA to hold training on the OPEN Government Act amendments; FOIA training was provided at the VA's annual Information Security conference; and the visits were made to field facilities to assess the quality of FOIA operations in the field.

In the area of technology and automation, VA improved its FOIA website by adding more user-friendly features to enrich the visitor session (a "Just Issued" and "Helpful Links" section was added). In addition, VA is pleased to report that after researching and reviewing FOIA automation software products, including internal VA, Government Off-the-Shelf (GOTS) and Commercial Off-the-Shelf (COTS) products, VA selected a vendor to design a custom system that will be configured for VA's department-wide use.

In the area of governance, the VA is updating and revising its FOIA regulations and FOIA Handbook to reflect changes in laws, policies, and procedures. Both documents are currently in the concurrence process. Also, VA continues to monitor its backlog by conducting quarterly "FOIA Snapshots" of its FOIA operations.

VA is pleased with its progress to date, but we also look forward to an even more rewarding fiscal year 2009.
