According to the American Psychiatric Association, "a recent study of 300,000 troops returning from Iraq and Afghanistan revealed that around 20% reported mental health concerns and one-third accessed mental health services in the first year home. Of those, 12% were found to have a mental health problem. Those exposed to the most combat and risk to their life are at greatest risk of mental health problems on return. Early identification and help-seeking in large numbers is good news, but we do not know the mental health effects on families and the degree to which they are seeking and receiving treatment" (http://healthyminds.org/couragetocare.cfm).

It is important for every VHA facility to have access to adequate resources for veterans AND their families, so that these individuals may supplement their clinical treatment with independent readings and information. VA staff should also benefit, since through educating themselves they will be better able to recognize, understand and communicate with affected veterans.
