What is Driver Distraction?

Driver Distraction

- Form of Inattention
- Shifts attention away from the task at hand
- Includes visual, cognitive, auditory and other elements

Potential causes

- In-vehicle technologies
- -Other passengers
- -External stimuli

Make selections only while stopped.






The Safety Problem of Distractors while Driving


