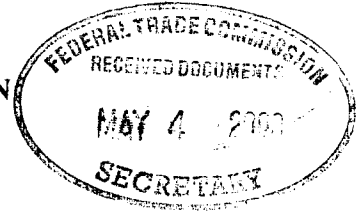

COMPLAINT COUNSEL'S AMENDED INITIAL DISCLOSURES

Complaint counsel hereby submits its amended initial disclosures to respondents Hoechst Marion Roussel, Inc., Carderm Capital, L.P., and Andrx Corporation under § 3.31(b) of the Federal Trade Commission's Rules of Practice for Adjudicative Proceedings. In the previous submission, The Wilkerson Group (a subsidiary of IBM) was inadvertently omitted from those organizations likely to have relevant information and those firms submitting relevant documents in this matter. This amendment reflects the addition of The Wilkerson Group to those lists.

Set forth below are the names, addresses, and telephone numbers of individuals likely to have discoverable information relevant to the allegations asserted in the complaint in this matter to the extent their identities are not privileged. 
