(4) the parties' execution of this Stipulation and the entry of Final Judgment settles, discharges, and releases any and all claims of the plaintiff arising from the acquisition by Defendants Anova Holding AG, Stephan Schmidheiny and Unotec Holding AG of voting securities of Landis & Gyr AG and Wild Leitz Holding AG:

(a) against the Defendants for failure to complywith any provision of § 7A of the Clayton Act, 15U.S.C. § 18a; and
