Series Description

The Miscellaneous File consists of documents which were received at the Eisenhower Library at various times but which were never integrated into the Principal or Secondary Files. The materials have been arranged in nine series.

1-4	<p>Appointment Books Series. 4 boxes.</p> <p>Appointment books and desk calendars kept by DDE's staff which list his daily activities. These cover the period from December 1945 through the 1952 campaign. Most of the information from these books has been published by Johns Hopkins University in Volumes 9, 11 and 13 of <u>The Papers of Dwight D. Eisenhower</u>. Appointment lists for the World War II period are in box 127 of the Principal File.</p>
5-7	<p>1952 Campaign Series. 3 boxes.</p> <p>This series contains two copies of the book "Campaign Statements of Dwight D. Eisenhower: A Reference Index." This was compiled by DDE's headquarters staff after the 1952 campaign to serve as a guide to the major subjects he mentioned in his campaign statements. Additional copies of the book are in the Eisenhower Library book collection and research room. The series also contains a card index listing names of persons who assisted with the work of DDE's campaign.</p>
8-10	<p>1946 Christmas Cards Series. 3 boxes.</p> <p>Christmas cards received by DDE in December 1946, arranged alphabetically. These cards were originally kept separate from the rest of DDE's papers but his staff later began to integrate them into the 1946-48 Routine Correspondence Series in the Secondary File. When DDE left the Army the work was halted and the files were put into storage. By that time the cards for letters A and C had been transferred to the Secondary File. Thus the A and C folders in this series only contain lists of the cards which had been removed.</p>
11-14	<p><u>Crusade in Europe</u> Manuscripts Series. 3½ boxes.</p> <p>Research notes, handwritten and typed drafts of DDE's book <u>Crusade in Europe</u>.</p>
14	<p>Guest Books Series. ¼ box.</p> <p>Four guest books containing names of persons who visited DDE's various offices. The first book was started at SHAEF during World War II but was taken to the War Department by DDE and contains entries as late as 1948. The other three books were used at DDE's offices at SHAPE during 1951 and 1952.</p>
14-15	<p>Offers of Real Estate Series. 1¼ boxes.</p>

When DDE was selected as President of Columbia University in late 1947 several newspapers declared that he would need a place to live in the New York City area. A number of real estate agents and private individuals wrote to offer him various properties. This series contains the correspondence which is filed geographically by location of the property.

16-17 SHAEF Operations Series. 1¼ boxes.

Copies of maps outlining the war situation in Europe in early 1945 and a report on the organization of SHAEF.

17-19 Travel and Entertainment Expense Series. 2¾ boxes.

Bills, receipts and memoranda pertaining to DDE's official travel and entertainment expenses while at SHAPE during 1951 and 1952. The files were kept by DDE's aide Craig Cannon.

20-21 Composite Series No. 1, 1909-. 2 boxes.

This series contains material received at the Eisenhower Library as individual documents. The material includes both original documents and copies of DDE-related documents at other repositories.

22-25 Composite Series No. 2, 1905-1941. 4 boxes.

Photocopies of documents authored by Dwight D. Eisenhower, his family, friends and associates as well as official government records. These were gathered from various archives in the course of research for the NARA documentary publication, Eisenhower: The Prewar Diaries and Selected Papers, 1905-1941.
