#### **Provenance**

The Janus Press Archive was purchased from Claire Van Vliet, proprietor of Janus Press, in September, 1991. As an open collection, additional materials are added as they are received.

### **Processing Information**

As far as possible, the material retains the arrangement provided by Claire Van Vliet, who has supplied distinctive boxes for housing. Often Van Vliet has arranged and labelled folders (these have been retained); when she has not, folders have been added for organizational and listing purposes, and materials grouped according to type, for example, correspondence followed by typescripts and paste-ups, production materials, etc. In order to connect the material in the Janus Press Archive to the resulting publication housed in the Janus Press Collection, also housed in the Rare Book and Special Collections Division, the LCCN for each work is noted in parentheses in this finding aid.

### **Access and Restrictions**

The records of the Janus Press Archive are open to research. Researchers are advised to contact the Rare Book and Special Collections Division reading room prior to visiting. Many collections are stored off-site and advance notice is needed to retrieve these items for research use.

# **Scope and Content Note**

The Janus Press Archive contains material relating to the production of books, posters and broadsides, and printed ephemera bearing the Janus Press imprint, as well as other projects carried out with the assistance of its founder Claire Van Vliet, covering the period from 1955 to the present.

Includes correspondence, annotated typescripts, proofs, paste-ups and layouts, book designers' mockups, woodblocks, linocut blocks, etched and engraved plates, binding structures, paper and fabric samples, a record and compact disc, notes, drawings, and receipts.

Correspondents include Clifford Burke, Bob Ewert, Ruth Fine, W.R. Johnson, Margaret Kaufman, Charles Seluzicki, Helen Siegl, the Limited Editions Club, Stinehour Press, and W.Thomas Taylor.

# **Organization of the Papers**

Organized into two series: I. Books. II. Posters and Broadsides. Arranged chronologically by publication date of work to which materials relate.
