Application to Participate in the Minutiae Interoperability Exchange Test (MINEX)

1. Who Should Participate

- 1.1. Developers of interoperable fingerprint minutiae matcher and/or fingerprint minutiae extraction software.
- 1.2. Developers of biometric products seeking compliance with NIST Special Publication 800-76 (section 7.4.1). Otherwise known as PIV compliance.
- 1.3. Anonymous participation will not be permitted.

2. How to Participate

- 2.1. In order to request participation in MINEX, potential participants must fill out this form (Application to Participate in MINEX) identifying the Responsible Party and the Point of Contact, print and sign the form, and send to the location designated below.
 - The Responsible Party is an individual with the authority to commit the organization to the terms in this document.
 - The Point of Contact is an individual with detailed knowledge of the system applying for participation.
- 2.2. Upon receipt of the signed form by the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST), the organization will be classified as a "Participant" in MINEX.
- 2.3. See the official MINEX website http://fingerprint.nist.gov/minex/ for details on submitting your software.

3. Points of Contact

- 3.1. The MINEX Liaison is the government point of contact for MINEX.
- 3.2. All correspondence should be directed to minex@nist.gov, which will be received by the MINEX Liaison and other MINEX personnel.
- 3.3. These correspondences may be posted on the FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions) area of the MINEX website at the discretion of the MINEX Liaison.
- 3.4. Interested parties and Participants should not contact any individual member of the MINEX staff.

4. Access to MINEX Sample Data

- 4.1. The MINEX Sample Dataset is supplied to Participants to assist in preparing for MINEX.
- 4.2. The fingerprints in the MINEX Sample Data are representative of the MINEX Test Data *only* in format. Image quality, collection device and other characteristics may vary between the Sample and Test Datasets.

5. Access to MINEX Test Data

- 5.1. MINEX Participants will have no access to MINEX Test Data, either before or after the test.
- 5.2. The MINEX Test Datasets will be protected under the Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C 552) and the Privacy Act (5 U.S.C. 552a) as applicable.

6. Release of MINEX Results

- 6.1. After the completion of MINEX testing, the Government will publish all results obtained along with the organization's name on the MINEX website (http://fingerprint.nist.gov/minex).
- 6.2. Participants will be notified of their results.
- 6.3. After the release of the MINEX results, Participants may decide to use the results for their own purposes. Such results shall be accompanied by the following phrase: "Results shown from the Minutiae Interoperability Exchange Test do not constitute endorsement of any particular system by the Government." Such results shall also be accompanied by the Internet address (URL) of the MINEX website.

7. Additional Information

- 7.1. Any data obtained during MINEX, as well as any documentation required by the Government from the participants, becomes the property of the Government. Participants will not possess a proprietary interest in the data and/or submitted documentation.
- 7.2. With the signing of this form, Participants attest that they will not file any MINEX-related claim against MINEX Sponsors, Supporters, staff, contractors, or agency of the U.S. Government, or otherwise seek compensation for any equipment, materials, supplies, information, travel, labor and/or other participant provided services.
- 7.3. The Government is not bound or obligated to follow any recommendations that may be submitted by the Participant. The United States Government, or any individual agency, is not bound, nor is it obligated, in any way to give any special consideration to MINEX Participants on future contracts.
