**from December 31, 2009 through March 31, 2010**

**LIST OF PROJECT ADDITIONS AND DELETIONS** - The following list of transportation projects identifies those projects that have been added or deleted from the five April 15, 2009 lists during the period December 31, 2009 through March 31, 2010. These additions and deletions are in addition to those reported as of October 1, 2009 and December 31, 2009. In summary, since December 31, 2009:

- 2 projects have been deleted and a project has been substituted in the same county for each.
- 1 project has been deleted.
- 43 new projects have been added.

As projects are awarded at less than the estimated project cost, additional projects can be added.

**SELECTING PROJECTS FOR ARRA FUNDING** - The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) continues to work with cities, counties, Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs) and other transportation partners throughout the state to implement ARRA projects.

**FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR TRANSPORTATION STIMULUS PROJECTS** - All candidate projects must meet federal requirements for federal transportation aid and have been assessed to ensure these requirements can be met within the approval timelines. The following are examples of the requirements applicable to transportation projects funded under the Act:

- All projects in a metropolitan area must be included in an approved Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). All projects located in a non-metropolitan area must be included in the STIP.
- Transit projects must be coordinated with the relevant transit operating agency, MPO or FDOT.
- Rail and airport projects should be coordinated with the relevant MPO and FDOT.
- Pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), all projects must have completed the required assessments of environmental impacts.
- Right of way on projects must have been acquired pursuant to the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies.
- American iron, steel and manufactured goods are to be used in projects, except in certain instances.

**FACTORS FOR PRIORITIZING PROJECTS** - Priority projects are those "shovel ready" projects which:

- Have been deferred by the state
- Are tied to concurrency where development is being held up
- Have the potential to generate revenues and jobs
- Are geographically balanced
- Provide congestion relief
- Are located in economically distressed areas
- Can be completed within 3 years
