Pursuant to Title XV, Subtitle A, Section 1511 of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (Pub. L. 111-5 (Feb. 17, 2009)) (ARRA), I, Michael B. Cline, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Transportation, hereby certify that the infrastructure investments funded with amounts appropriated by ARRA under the headings: "Highway Infrastructure Investment" to the Federal Highways Administration; "Transit Capital Assistance," "Fixed Guideway Infrastructure Investment" and "Capital Investment Grants" to the Federal Transit Administration are included in the Indiana Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (the "STIP")

I further certify that the specific information required by Section 1511 concerning each such investment (a description of the investment, the estimated total cost, and the amount of ARRA funds to be used) is provided on the amended STIP, as described above, and is available at <http://www.in.gov/indot/2926.htm> and linked to Recovery.gov.

I understand that my State or local agency may not receive ARRA infrastructure investment funding unless this certification is made and posted.
