New Options

SCENI IEMM ERROR CORRECTION [Correct Incomplete Encounters] This option allows a user to correct the errors to an encounter or patient demographic. The correction protocols of this option are locked by the SCENI IEMM EDIT and SCENI ENCOUNTER EDIT security keys. Please review the New Security Key section for further details.

SCENI IEMM ERROR REPORT [Incomplete Encounter Error Report] This option allows the user to obtain a list of incomplete encounters.

SCENI IEMM ERROR SORT [Incomplete Encounters by Error Code] This option provides the user with a list of the errors which are in the TRANSMITTED OUTPATIENT ENCOUNTER ERROR CODE file (#409.76).

SCENI IEMM MAIN MENU [Incomplete Encounter Management] This menu holds the SCENI IEMM REPORTS MENU submenu and the SCENI IEMM ERROR CORRECTION option.

SCENI IEMM REPORTS MENU [Incomplete Encounter Reports] This menu contains the following options.

SCENI IEMM ERROR REPORT [Incomplete Encounter Error Report] SCENI IEMM ERROR SORT [Incomplete Encounters by Error Code] SCENI IEMM SUMMARY REPORT [Summary Report - IEMM] SCENI PT ALPHA LIST [Alpha List of Incomplete Encounters]

SCENI IEMM SUMMARY BULLETIN [IEMM Summary Bulletin] This option can be scheduled to run nightly to produce the summary report. It will generate a bulletin, thus no output device is needed. The bulletin produced is SCDX INCOMPLETE ENCOUNTER MGMT.

SCENI IEMM SUMMARY REPORT [Summary Report - IEMM] This option allows a user to gather summary information about the number of encounters sent and accepted.

SCENI OP ENCOUNTER EDIT [Edit Outpatient Encounter] This option allows a user to edit actual encounter-specific data. It is locked by the SCENI ENCOUNTER EDIT security key. It is located on the [SCENI OP ENCOUNTER EDIT] Supervisor Ambulatory Care menu.

SCENI PT ALPHA LIST [Alpha List of Incomplete Encounters] This option allows the user to print a list of all errors found in the TRANSMITTED OUTPATIENT ENCOUNTER ERROR file (#409.75) at the time the report is generated.

New Bulletin

SCDX INCOMPLETE ENCOUNTER MGMT

This bulletin is used when the Incomplete Encounter report is scheduled as a nightly job. A mail group must be assigned to this bulletin.

New Background Job

SCENI IEMM SUMMARY BULLETIN

This is a new background job that may be scheduled. It will report the same information as the SCENI IEMM SUMMARY REPORT menu option.

New Print Templates

Template SCENI ERROR LIST has been added to the TRANSMITTED OUTPATIENT ENCOUNTER ERROR file (#409.75). This template is used to print errors sorted by error code.

Template SCENI PAT ALPHA PRINT has been added to the TRANSMITTED OUTPATIENT ENCOUNTER ERROR file (#409.75). This template is used to print errors sorted by patient.

Template SCENI ERROR TABLE has been added to the TRANSMITTED OUTPATIENT ENCOUNTER ERROR CODE file (#409.76). This template is used to print the error codes and their descriptions. At this time, it may only be accessed through FileMan.

New Sort Templates

Template SCENI ERROR SORT has been added to the TRANSMITTED OUTPATIENT ENCOUNTER ERROR file (#409.75). This template is used to sort errors by error code.

Template SCENI PT ALPHA SORT has been added to the TRANSMITTED OUTPATIENT ENCOUNTER ERROR file (#409.75). This template is used to sort errors by patient.

Modified Input Template

Input template SDB, which is used in the clinic setup, has been modified to ask the new clinic parameter - WORKLOAD VALIDATION AT CHK OUT.

Modified Print Template

Print template SCDX Transmitted Error List, which is used to display the errors in the TRANSMITTED OUTPATIENT ENCOUNTER ERROR file (#409.75), has been modified to print the source of the error.

New Security Keys

New security keys, SCENI IEMM EDIT, SCENI ENCOUNTER EDIT, and SCENI MEANS TEST EDIT lock the following protocols and options. Because of the nature of the data which can be edited through the Edit Outpatient Encounter option, it is highly recommended that the SCENI ENCOUNTER EDIT security key not be given to all users.

SCENI MEANS TEST EDIT

This key is used to limit the users who can complete a Means Test through Load/Edit when using the IEMM correction tool.

Event Handler Changes

The Ambulatory Care event handler, SCDX AMBCARE EVENT, currently exists as an item on the PIMS event driver, SDAM APPOINTMENT EVENTS. The post init routine will remove it from the item list and add it to the exit action of that same protocol. This is to ensure that the capturing and validation of workload data is the last event to be processed.

 A new field has been added - WORKLOAD VALIDATION AT CHK OUT (#30).

 This field is used to determine if the validation software is to be executed at the completion of a successfully checked-out encounter.

User Release Notes

Introduction

This patch installs the Incomplete Encounter Management Module (IEMM), part of the Ambulatory Care Reporting Project (ACRP) Phase II. The patch will provide the data validation tools necessary for sites to maintain the correctness of outpatient data being transmitted to the Austin Automation Center.

Validator

The validation logic is a new piece of functionality installed with this patch. The previous Ambulatory Care software only checked to ensure that a value was present in each data field sent to Austin. It did not check the validity of that data. This new software will perform the same validation checks as the Austin database to identify errors before they are transmitted. The validator (or edit checker) will review the entire encounter rather than stopping after the first error is found. All errors are stored for later reporting and correction.

This validation will continue to be performed during the nightly background job. It can also be performed when there is a complete check out for an appointment. This is provided if the parameter WORKLOAD VALIDATION AT CHK OUT for the respective clinic is set to YES, and an entry exists in the TRANSMITTED OUTPATIENT ENCOUNTER file. The validation software will also be executed as part of the Correct Incomplete Encounters menu option.

Error Correction Tools

Tools have been developed to help users correct the errors that are found in encounters. The Correct Incomplete Encounters option allows a user to select, display, and correct errors using a List Manager display format. After an attempt is made to correct the error, the validator will be run for that encounter to check for any additional errors. If an error is found it will be presented to the user. The correction actions of this option are locked with the SCENI IEMM EDIT security key except for the Encounter Information action which is locked with the SCENI ENCOUNTER EDIT security key.

The Edit Outpatient Encounter option allows a user with the SCENI ENCOUNTER EDIT security key to correct specific data for an encounter. Four data items for the encounter are available for correction: appointment type, division, clinic stop code, and eligibility.

New Menu Options

The Incomplete Encounter Management menu has been added to the Ambulatory Care Reporting menu. This new menu contains the Incomplete Encounter Reports submenu and the Correct Incomplete Encounters option.

Incomplete Encounter Reports

These reports will only display those errors remaining in the TRANSMITTED OUTPATIENT ENCOUNTER ERROR file since the **last** running of the encounter validation software. This file is dynamic and is updated each time the validator runs.

Alpha List of Incomplete Encounters - This report provides a list of all errors found in the TRANSMITTED OUTPATIENT ENCOUNTER ERROR file (#409.75) at the time the report is generated.

Incomplete Encounter Error Report - This report provides a detailed report of errors by patient with a wide range of selection criteria and encounter identifying information.

Incomplete Encounters by Error Code - This report provides a list of the errors which are in the TRANSMITTED OUTPATIENT ENCOUNTER ERROR CODE file (#409.76).

Summary Report – IEMM - This report prints a summary showing total encounters for a date range and the number and percentage of incomplete encounters. The report may be printed as summary only or summary with detail.

Correct Incomplete Encounters - This option allows a user to select, display, and correct errors using a List Manager display format.

The Edit Outpatient Encounter option has been added to the Supervisor Ambulatory Care menu. It allows you to change four fields which are set by the software and are normally uneditable.

New Bulletin

This patch installs a new bulletin, SCDX INCOMPLETE ENCOUNTER MGMT. This bulletin provides the same information as the Summary Report - IEMM option, but in a bulletin format. The bulletin is sent to a user-defined mail group.

The nightly bulletin from the processing of the encounters to Austin currently contains all of the encounters with errors. This has been changed so that the bulletin only contains a summary report. The individual errors can be viewed through the new report options.

SCENI MEANS TEST EDIT

This key is used to limit the users who can complete a Means Test through Load/Edit when using the IEMM correction tool.

Registration (DG) Changes

The Load/Edit Patient Data option [DG LOAD PATIENT DATA] has been changed. The system determines a patient's need for Means Testing and Copay Testing and, if necessary, now allows you to complete the required test through this option. For the Copay Test, the veteran has to request the test be completed.

If the user is accessing Load/Edit through the IEMM correction tool, the SCENI MEANS TEST EDIT key will be used to restrict users from completing the Means Test.
