2010 National Survey of Veterans

Released August 5, 2011

The 2010 National Survey of Veterans (NSV) is the sixth in a series of national surveys designed by the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) to help plan for future programs and services for Veterans.

For the first time, the NSV was expanded to include additional target populations:

- Veterans
- Veteran Spouses
- Active Duty Servicemembers
- Active Duty Spouses
- Demobilized National Guard and Reserve Members
- Surviving Spouses

Major objectives:

- Obtain information useful for planning and allocating resources for Veterans' programs and services.
- Compare characteristics of Veterans who use VA benefits and services with those who do not.
- Study VA's role in the delivery of all benefits and services.
- Assess the awareness of benefits and services among Veterans and other stakeholder groups.






2010 National Survey of Veterans: Key Findings

Ranked by Period of Military Service








2010 National Survey of Veterans: Key Findings
