

Multidisciplinary Approach to Pain and the Effects of Opiate <u>Discontinuation on Pain and Disability</u>

A webinar series offered by the American Osteopathic Academy of Addiction Medicine (AOAAM)

Abstract Management of Chronic Non Malignant Pain (CNMP) poses multiple challenges. While the disease burden is significant, there are limited treatment options with proven improvement in functional outcomes. Multiple studies have shown Multidisciplinary functional rehabilitation to be effective in pain reduction and functional restoration. Chronic opiate therapy is fraught with challenges including addiction, death and opiate induced pain disorders. This webinar introduces practitioners to the outcomes of discontinuation of opiate therapy and in CNMP and discusses strategies for management of comorbic CNMP and Opiate addiction.

Prescribers' Clinical Support System for Opioid Therapies (PCSS-O) is a three year grant funded by Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), Center for Substance Abuse Treatment (CSAT). It is a collaborative project led by American Academy of Addiction Psychiatry (AAAP) with: American Dental Association (ADA), American Medical Association (AMA), American Osteopathic Academy of Addiction Medicine (AOAAM), American Psychiatric Association (APA), American Society for Pain Management Nursing (ASPMN), and International Nurses Society on Addictions (IntNSA). These organizations are providing training and education on the safe and effective prescribing of opioid medications in the treatment of pain and/or opioid addiction.

SPEAKER BIO:

Dr Mathews is the section head of the Pain Medicine at the Neurological Center for pain at the Cleveland Clinic Foundation, Cleveland, OH. He completed a residency in Psychiatry before completing a Pain Medicine Fellowship at the same institution. He is trained in multiple aspects of pain management including interventional procedures, pharmacological and psychotherapeutic management of pain. He has authored various articles and book chapters and is an invited speaker at various conferences.
