The Library of Congress's 2020 National Book Festival will be held through virtual stages from September 25-27. The all-digital format will allow attendees to navigate events from their homes and to follow "Timely Topic Threads" through specific online portals.

The Women's Suffrage Centennial Commission is sponsoring the "Fearless Women" thread, featuring 23 authors in 19 programs, including discussions with former Secretary of State **Madeleine Albright**, U.S. Poet Laureate **Joy Harjo**, philanthropist **Melinda Gates**, and lawyer and disability rights advocate **Haben Girma**, among many other trailblazing women who carry forward the legacy of the suffragists. Members of the Commission will join featured authors on the "Fearless Women" virtual stage for author interviews, introductions, and moderated discussions.

Author presentation videos for children and teens will be released at 9 a.m. ET tomorrow, September 25. All author presentation videos on other stages will launch at 9 a.m. ET on September 26.
