What's a Blog?

- A blog is:
 - A content management system
 - Produces chronologically ordered content
 - · Web-based
 - Simple User Interface
 - A website
 - Produced by a blog platform
 - Often invites interaction (comments)
- These terms are interchangeable

Blogging Best Practices

- Your blog should belong to you
 - Blog platforms should be disconnected from your URL
 - youragency.blogspot.com = Not great
 - blog.youragency.gov = AWESOME
- Blogs are conversational
 - Blogs are not press releases
 - Blogs are not position papers
 - Blogs are not footnoted
- Blogs are easy to follow
 - Support RSS
 - Offer e-mail subscriptions too

Know When to Engage

- Common Sense Rules
 - Empower employees, but ensure they know their limits (and yours)
- Respond conversationally
- Each response is an opportunity to remind people that the blog is worth visiting
 - When they visit, make sure they become repeat visitors
