If you are in England and feel like you may have swine flu, visit the National Pandemic Flu Service by following the link below, or call 0800 1 513 100 (textphone - 0800 1 513 200).

People who have swine flu symptoms will be given a unique access number and told where their nearest antiviral collection point is. They should then ask a flu friend - a friend or relative who doesn't have swine flu - to go and pick up their antivirals from their nearest antiviral collection point. The flu friend must show their own ID as well as that of the patient.

### Latest news - 12 November 2009

There were 64,000 new cases of swine flu in England last week, down nearly 25 per cent on the week before when there were 84,000 new cases.

Most new cases in the last week have been among the under-one and one to four age groups.

The Health Protection Agency estimates there have been 668,000 cases of swine flu in the UK since the pandemic began.

### Swine flu vaccine

Vaccinations against swine flu began on 21 October. People in high-risk groups, such as those most at risk from seasonal flu and pregnant women, are being given priority.

Vaccination against swine flu is not compulsory, but people in high-risk groups are being strongly advised to have the vaccination.

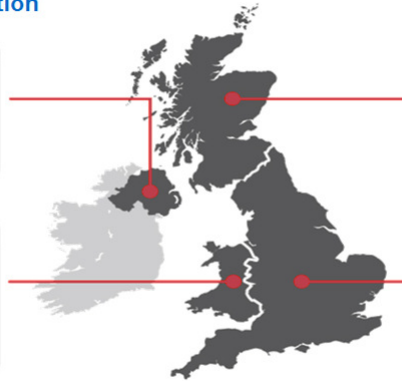

What is 2009 H1N1 (swine flu)?

2009 H1N1 (sometimes called "swine flu") is a new influenza virus causing illness in people. This new virus was first detected in people in the United States in April 2009. This virus is spreading from person-to-person worldwide, probably in much the same way that regular seasonal influenza viruses spread. On June 11, 2009, the [World Health Organization](#) (WHO) signaled that a pandemic of 2009 H1N1 flu was underway.

Why is 2009 H1N1 virus sometimes called "swine flu"?

This virus was originally referred to as "swine flu" because laboratory testing showed that many of the genes in this new virus were very similar to influenza viruses that

## Understanding the difference between H1N1 Flu and Cold symptoms

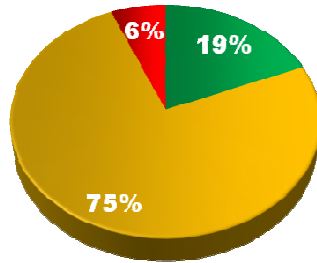
The following table provides a general guide to symptoms associated with H1N1 flu and the common cold. However, only a health care professional can reliably diagnose a respiratory illness.

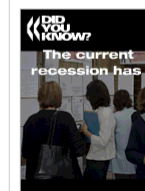

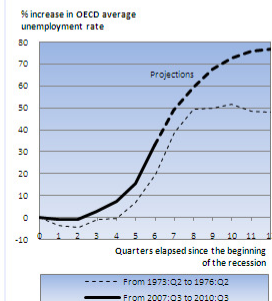

#### Did you know?

##### The current unemployment hike is the worst in recent decades



The **unemployment rate** in the OECD area reached 8.5% in July 2009 and it **could approach 10% by 2010**. This is the steepest increase in the post-war period.

Most countries have scaled up resources for labour market and social policies to support the rapidly growing number of unemployed, but additional funds are often rather limited and governments are facing difficult choices on how best to respond to the different demands.
